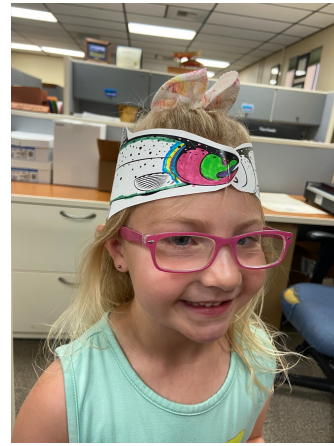


Additional Length

Materials:

- Coloring Crayons or Markers
- Scissors
- Stapler or quick drying glue
- Pencil



Instructions:

- 1) Color each trout then cut both out on the dotted line.
- 2) Using a stapler, or glue, attach each nose of the fish together leaving the color on the outside.
- 3) Place the attached noses on the child's forehead and wrap each fish around both sides of the head to create a Headband-like shape.
- 4) Bring together the tail fins of each fish, measure where the hat will fit snug to the child's head and mark that location with the pencil for a second staple or to place the glue.
- 5) Take the headband off the child to place staple or glue.

**When the second staple or glue is dry the Fish Headband is ready to be worn!**

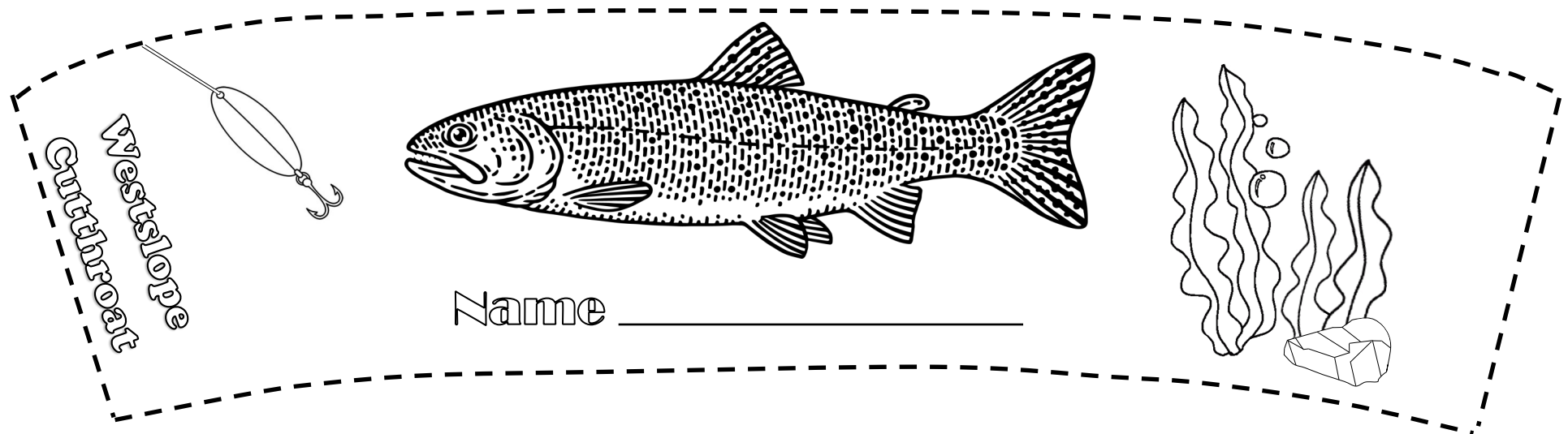
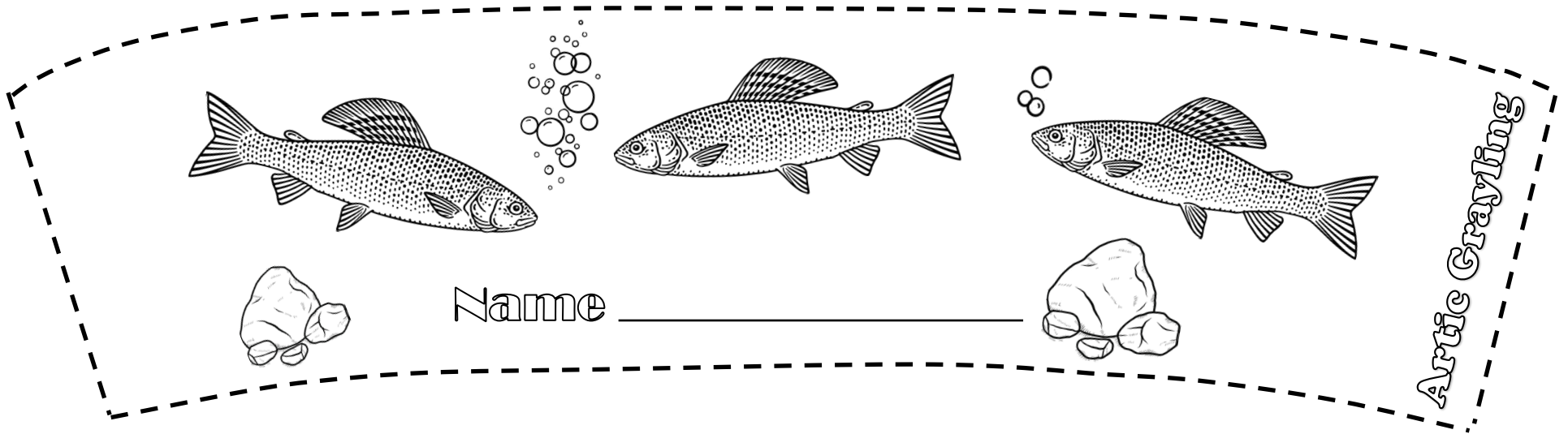
**\*\*NOTE\*\*** If more length is need, cut out the additional length panel with the bobber and attached to the tail of the fish then re-size on the child's head.

**Instructions**

1. Color the fish inside the dotted lines.

2. Cut the sleeve out along the outside dotted line.

3. Fold around 12 ounce size cup or pop can and use clear tape to attach.
