- 2024 plans alter mix to more drought tolerant species.



Freezout Lake

- 2023 Spring plantings & light disking completed on time.
- Fair-Good spring precipitation.
- End of contract. Monitoring and weed control moving forward.







Woods Bottom Project


- Crop conversion on BLM land near Loma ,MT
