The fee structure does not charge enough for commercial videographers. Basically, those that are filming fishing and hunting shows for TV. These folks make \$\$ from sponsors, commercials, the TV stations, etc. They should be paying \$1000/day per event no matter what size their crew is. This should go for land-based videos too. Public and Private lands should be included in the commercial forprofit filming of fishing & hunting resources.

An alternative may be to issue an annual license. \$250 for residents, \$1000 for non-residents.
