Deer/Elk Hunting Districts (HD): 121

Hunting Access Dates: September 1 – December 31, 2016

## GENERAL INFORMATION

The Avista - Bull River Block Management Area (BMA) is located in Sanders County, about 15 miles north of Noxon. Hunting on 155 acres is provided entirely by the Avista Corporation.

This BMA offers hunting opportunities for white-tailed deer, mule deer, elk, moose, upland game birds and waterfowl.

There is a weapons restriction on this BMA: **Only shotgun, muzzleloader, traditional handgun or archery equipment hunting is allowed.**

## PERMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Each hunter is required to register *daily* at the sign-in box *before* beginning to hunt on this BMA. Registration details are posted on-site at the sign-in box. Each hunter must carry the daily permission coupon at all times while hunting on this BMA.

## HOW TO GET THERE

➔ From Noxon, travel northwest on Highway 200 approximately 5 miles to the junction with Highway 56;

➔ Turn north onto Highway 56 and travel 9 miles to the BMA parking area located near mile marker 9.

## REGULATIONS

1. All access is walk-in from the designated parking area.
2. Hunters are required to park in the designated parking area.
3. A maximum of 2 vehicles is allowed at the designated parking area. If there are 2 vehicles in the parking area, then further hunter access to this BMA is denied until at least one of the vehicles has left. Vehicles must be parked in a manner so as not to obstruct roadways or gates for landowner access.
4. Hunters may only use a shotgun, muzzleloader, traditional handgun or archery equipment on this BMA.
5. It is unlawful to commercially outfit on this BMA.
6. Failure to abide by the regulations for this BMA can result in a trespass violation under MCA 45-6-203 and/or a violation of FWP Department or Commission orders or rules under MCA 87-6-201.


