Hunting Access Dates: September 1 – December 31, 2016
2017 Spring Turkey Season*

GENERAL INFORMATION

The Avista - Tuscor Block Management Area (BMA) is located in Sanders County, about 4 ½ miles west of Trout Creek. Hunting on 500 acres is provided by the Avista Corporation.

This BMA offers hunting opportunities for white-tailed deer, mule deer, elk, upland game birds, waterfowl and turkey.

PERMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Reservations for written permission will be issued on a first-come, first-served basis by calling the Avista Noxon Office (406) 847-1281. Reservations will begin **Monday, August 22 at 12:00 NOON** and will continue Monday - Friday, 8 AM - 4 PM.

Up to **four hunters** will be granted access per day. Each hunter may reserve no more than 2 days each week and may not make further reservations until their hunting period is completed.

HOW TO GET THERE

➔ From Trout Creek, travel northwest on Martin Creek Road approximately 4.5 miles to the BMA's southern boundary and parking area.

REGULATIONS

1. All access is walk-in from designated parking areas.
2. Hunters are required to park in designated parking areas.
3. It is unlawful to commercially outfit on this BMA.
4. Failure to abide by the regulations for this BMA can result in a trespass violation under MCA 45-6-203 and/or a violation of FWP Department or Commission orders or rules under MCA 87-6-201.

**Dates for the 2017 Spring Turkey season will be available in the spring of 2017.*


