GENERAL INFORMATION

The Stimson – Troy Area Block Management Area (BMA) is located in Lincoln County and consists of Stimson Lumber Company's dispersed lands near Troy. Hunting on 21,428 acres is provided entirely by Stimson Lumber Company.

This BMA offers hunting opportunities for white-tailed deer, mule deer, elk, moose, black bear, upland game birds, and turkey.

PERMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Permission is not required to hunt on the BMA.

REGULATIONS

1. Motorized travel allowed only on *DESIGNATED ACCESS ROUTES*.
2. Non-motorized travel is open to foot, horseback or nonmotorized bicycle.
3. No camping or campfires.
4. No firewood cutting.
5. No littering. Pack it in, pack it out.
6. It is unlawful to commercially outfit on this BMA.
7. Failure to abide by the regulations for this BMA can result in a trespass violation under MCA 45-6-203 and/or a violation of FWP Department or Commission orders or rules under MCA 87-6-201.


