Deer/Elk Hunting District: 260

Hunting is NOT allowed on Tuesdays or Thursdays

Hunting Access Dates: September 3, 2016 – December 31, 2016

GENERAL INFORMATION

The Teller Wildlife Refuge Block Management Area (BMA) is located in Ravalli County; the office is one mile north of Corvallis at the corner of Eastside Highway and Quast Lane. This BMA offers the opportunity to archery hunt white-tailed deer on 45 acres near the Bitterroot River bottom.

The Teller Wildlife Refuge is a private not-for-profit wildlife refuge; their website can be visited at www.tellerwildlife.org.

PERMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Written permission is required to hunt this BMA and hunter numbers are limited. Hunting periods will be filled on a first-come, first-served basis by calling the Region 2 Hunting Access Office (406)542-5530. Reservations will begin **Friday, August 26 at 12:00 noon** and will continue Monday - Friday, 8 am-5 pm.

➤ Two hunters will be granted access per two-week hunt period (beginning every other Saturday). **Hunting is NOT allowed on Tuesdays or Thursdays.**

➤ Hunters may reserve no more than one hunting period at a time, and may not make further reservations until they have completed the reserved hunting period.

➤ Each hunter who obtains permission will be sent a notification letter, written permission slip, mandatory mail-in survey card and specific hunting guidelines.

Be sure to place one permission slip face up on the dash of your vehicle and keep the other with you while hunting.

➤ **The Liability Release Form must be returned to the Teller Wildlife Refuge at least one week prior to your hunt period.**

HOW TO GET THERE

From the Highway 93 and Woodside Cutoff Road intersection drive east, towards Corvallis, approximately $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile until you reach Catherine Lane, turn north onto Catherine Lane, travel approximately $\frac{1}{4}$ of a mile and the parking area will be on your left.

REGULATIONS

1. Archery hunting for white-tailed deer ONLY allowed on this BMA.
2. **Each hunter who obtains permission to hunt this BMA is required to return the mandatory mail-in survey card once each hunt period is completed.**
3. All access is walk-in from designated parking areas.
4. All hunters must comply with Teller's Deer Hunting Guidelines.
5. It is unlawful to commercially outfit on this BMA.
6. Failure to abide by the regulations for this BMA can result in a trespass violation under MCA 45-6-203 and/ or a violation of FWP Department or Commission orders or rules under MCA 87-6-201.
