Bear Management Unit: 200

Hunting Access Dates: September 1, 2016 – January 18, 2017

GENERAL INFORMATION

The Loge Ranch Block Management Area (BMA) is located in Mineral County outside of St. Regis (about 70 miles northwest of Missoula). Hunting is provided by a private landowner on 449 acres.

This BMA offers hunters access to adjacent state lands, as well as hunting opportunities for white-tailed deer, mule deer, elk, black bear, wolf, mountain grouse, turkey and waterfowl. The Loge Ranch BMA has two separate units:

Smith Ranch Unit (56 acres) borders the Clark Fork River. This unit offers hunting opportunities for white-tailed deer and waterfowl.

Four Mile Unit (393 acres) offers hunting opportunities for white-tailed deer, mule deer, elk, black bear, and mountain grouse.

PERMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Every hunter is required to register daily at one of the sign-in boxes before beginning to hunt. Registration details are posted on site at each sign-in box.

Each hunter must carry the daily permission coupon at all times while hunting on this BMA.

HOW TO GET THERE

From the 4-way stop at St. Regis (north of Interstate Highway 90):

→ Smith Ranch Unit: Drive 0.5 miles southeasterly on W Old Highway 10E (from the 4-way) and just after the second bridge is Mill Creek Road on the left; take this road 0.7 miles north to Smith Ranch Road; turn left onto Smith Ranch Road and drive 0.3 miles to the parking area and sign-in box.

→ Four Mile Unit: Drive 1.5 miles southeasterly (from the 4-way) to a fork in the road (just after a cattle guard); go left at the fork and proceed about one mile to the parking area and sign-in box at the green house (136 Four Mile Road).

REGULATIONS

1. Motorized vehicle travel is not allowed on this BMA. Access is only allowed on foot from designated travel routes and sign-in boxes. Be prepared to park and walk-in.
2. Motorized game retrieval may be allowed on some roads after first obtaining landowner permission.
3. Do not park vehicles in such a manner as to obstruct traffic. Do not block gates.
4. Camping is not allowed on this BMA.
5. It is unlawful to commercially outfit on this BMA.
6. Failure to abide by the regulations for this BMA can result in a trespass violation under MCA 45-6-203 and/or a violation of FWP Department or Commission orders or rules under MCA 87-6-201.


