## GENERAL INFORMATION

The Morrison Peak Block Management Area (BMA) is located approximately 20 miles east of Missoula. Hunting on about 21,585 acres is provided by The Nature Conservancy (TNC), private landowners, Bureau of Land Management (BLM), University of Montana (UM) Lubrecht Experimental Forest and the Montana Department of Natural Resources and Conservation (DNRC).

This BMA provides hunting opportunities for white-tailed deer, mule deer, elk, black bear, wolf, and mountain grouse.

## PERMISSION REGULATIONS

Permission is not required to hunt on this BMA.

## HOW TO GET THERE

From Missoula, go east on Interstate Highway 90 about 4 miles; take Bonner exit #109 and go northeasterly on MT Highway 200 about:

► 11 miles to the Johnsrud Park Road (turn left at Johnsrud Fishing Access Site sign). This road provides access to the northern part of the BMA and rejoins Highway 200 (as Ninemile Prairie Road) at Roundup Fishing Access Site. Parking sites for hunting access are marked along this road.

► 16 to 24 miles and look for signs and parking areas along the north side of Highway 200. Please note that there are several parcels along the highway that are not part of this BMA.

## REGULATIONS

1. Motorized vehicle travel is not allowed on this BMA, except within designated parking areas as posted. Landowners, state, federal and county officials in the course of administrative work and official duties, will be exempt from these vehicle restrictions.
2. Travel off-road or on closed roads is open only to foot, horse or non-motorized bicycle.
3. Do not park vehicles in such a manner as to obstruct traffic. DO NOT BLOCK GATES.
4. Camping is allowed on TNC and public lands (BLM, DNRC and UM; see exceptions).
5. Camping is limited to a total period of not more than 16 days during any 28-day period (see exceptions). Both the 16-day and the 28-day periods start the first day the camp and/or camp gear is on-site.

Following the 16-day camp period, persons may not relocate a camp within the Morrison Peak BMA until the 28-day period has lapsed. Upon the end of the 16-day camping period, all camps must be completely removed. This includes the removal of all property. The state's litter laws will be enforced if any refuse is left.

**Camping Exceptions:** (1) Camping along the Blackfoot River and/or the Johnsrud Park/ Ninemile Prairie Road is only allowed in designated FWP campgrounds (fee required), and the camping limit is 7 days (during any 30 day period); (2) To camp on BLM land, you must be further than ¼ mile from the river and from the Johnsrud/Ninemile Prairie Road; and (3) To camp on UM land, you must be further than 50 feet from the ordinary high-water mark of the river.

6. Hunters using horses and pack stock are required to use certified weed-free hay on this BMA. Livestock is not allowed in FWP campgrounds.
7. Do not enter or shoot into Safety (No Trespassing) Zones. There may be safety zones posted in this BMA that are not indicated on the accompanying map. If an injured animal crosses into a safety zone, *do not follow it*. A Game Warden must go with you if it is necessary to retrieve game within a safety zone.
8. It is unlawful to commercially outfit on this BMA.
9. Failure to abide by the regulations for this BMA can result in a trespass violation under MCA 45-6-203 and/or a violation of FWP Department or Commission orders or rules under MCA 87-6-201.


