GENERAL INFORMATION

The Sunny Slope Block Management Area (BMA) is located in Lewis and Clark County, south of Lincoln. Hunting on about 9,930 acres is provided by private landowners and the Montana Department of Natural Resources and Conservation (DNRC).

This BMA offers hunting opportunities for elk, mule deer, white-tailed deer, black bear, wolf and mountain grouse. This BMA also provides access to adjacent state and federal lands.

PERMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Written permission is required to hunt on this BMA. To receive written permission stop by the ranch or call (406) 362-4408 in the evening between 7:00 PM and 9:00 PM.

After receiving written permission, **every hunter is required to register daily at one of the Sunny Slope BMA sign-in boxes before beginning to hunt.** Every hunter must carry the daily permission coupon at all times while hunting on this BMA.

HOW TO GET THERE

Sunny Slope BMA is three miles south of Lincoln, about 75 miles east of Missoula or 50 miles northwest of Helena. Primary access roads include:

→ Dalton Mountain Road #329 joins Montana Highway 200 about 2½ miles west of Lincoln and provides access to the central portion of the BMA.

→ Stemple Pass Road #601 joins Montana Highway 200 in downtown Lincoln and provides access to the eastern portion of the BMA.

→ Herrin Lake Road connects to the Dalton Mountain and Stemple Pass Roads and provides access to the northeastern portion of the BMA.

REGULATIONS

1. Motor vehicle travel is allowed only on roads designated open to motorized travel on the accompanying map. Hunters should park vehicles along the Dalton Mountain, Herrin Lakes or Stemple Pass Roads and access the area by non-motorized methods and be prepared to retrieve game by non-motorized methods. Travel on closed roads is open to foot, horse or non-motorized bicycle only.
2. Do not park any vehicle in such a manner as to obstruct traffic or block any gate.
3. Do not trespass or shoot into Safety Zones. There may be Safety Zones within this BMA that are not marked on the accompanying map.
4. Camping is not allowed on private land within this BMA. Camping on DNRC lands is allowed; consult DNRC's "Guide to Recreational Use of Montana's State Trust Lands."
5. It is unlawful to commercially outfit on this BMA.
6. Failure to abide by the regulations for this BMA can result in a trespass violation under MCA 45-6-203 and/or a violation of FWP Department or Commission orders or rules under MCA 87-6-201.


