## GENERAL INFORMATION

The Nevada-Ogden Block Management Area (BMA) is located east of Helmville in Powell County. Hunting on 7,280 acres is provided by private landowners.

This BMA offers hunting opportunities for elk, mule deer, white-tailed deer, black bear, wolf and mountain grouse.

\*Hunters are strongly encouraged to harvest **antlerless** elk on this BMA, in order to help achieve elk population goals in HD 298.

## PERMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Written permission is required to hunt on this BMA, and hunter numbers are limited. Reservations will be issued on a first-come, first-served basis by calling Region 2 Hunting Access Office at (406) 542-5530. Reservations will begin **Friday, October 7 at 8:00 AM** and will continue Monday-Friday, 8 AM - 5 AM.

► Up to **15 hunters per day** will be permitted access. 12 hunters will receive permission for elk\* & deer hunting and 3 hunters will receive permission for deer hunting *only*.

► Hunters may reserve no more than **3 days** at a time and may not make further reservations until they have completed their hunting period.

## HOW TO GET THERE

### **From Missoula:**

On Interstate Highway 90 (I-90) about 4 miles east of Missoula, take Bonner exit #109, go easterly on MT Highway 200 about 55 miles to the junction with MT Highway 141,

► Proceed south on Highway 141 about 5 miles.

### **From Helena:**

Go west on Highway 12 about 35 miles to Avon.

► Then go northwest on MT Highway 141 about 25 miles.

## REGULATIONS

1. Two permission slips will be issued per hunter. Hunters are required to place one permission slip face up on the dash of their vehicle and keep the other with them while hunting.
2. Motorized vehicle use is not allowed on this BMA. Access is by foot, horseback or non-motorized mountain bike. Hunters should park at access points along Montana Highway 141 or along the Ogden Mountain Road #1163.
3. Do not park any vehicle in such a manner as to obstruct traffic or block any gate.
4. Hunters may gain vehicle access for game retrieval after first checking at the Mannix residence, as shown on the accompanying map.
5. Camping is not allowed on this BMA.
6. It is unlawful to commercially outfit on this BMA.
7. Failure to abide by the regulations for this BMA can result in a trespass violation under MCA 45-6-203 and/or a violation of FWP Department or Commission orders or rules under MCA 87-6-201.


