Deer/Elk Hunting District (HD) 290

ARCHERY ONLY AREA FOR BIG GAME HUNTING

Hunting Access Dates: September 3, 2016 – January 1, 2017

GENERAL INFORMATION

The Dry Gulch Block Management Area (BMA) is located in Powell County, 2 miles southeast of Ovando. Hunting on about 600 acres is provided by a private landowner.

This BMA offers hunting opportunities for black bear, elk, mule deer, white-tailed deer, black bear and wolf.

WEAPONS RESTRICTIONS

This BMA is within the East Ovando Archery-only Area of Hunting District 290 where only archery equipment use is allowed for hunting big game.

PERMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Every hunter is required to register daily at one of the sign-in boxes before beginning to hunt on this BMA. Registration details are posted on site at the sign-in boxes.

Every hunter must carry the daily permission coupon at all times while hunting on this BMA.

HOW TO GET THERE

From Ovando, drive east on MT Highway 200 about 3.3 miles to Dry Gulch Road.

➔ Proceed southwest on Dry Gulch Road to the two parking areas/sign-in boxes located on this road.

REGULATIONS

1. Motorized travel is not allowed on this BMA. Access is walk-in only.
2. Do not park vehicles in such a manner as to obstruct traffic or block any gate.
3. Only portable archery stands are allowed. Do not leave stands for extended periods. FWP and/or landowners are not responsible for theft or destruction of stands or other personal property.
4. Keep away from residences and outbuildings.
5. Camping is not allowed on this BMA.
6. It is unlawful to commercially outfit on this BMA.
7. Failure to abide by the regulations for this BMA can result in a trespass violation under MCA 45-6-203 and/or a violation of FWP Department or Commission orders or rules under MCA 87-6-201.


