Hunting Access Dates: September 1 - November 27, 2016

GENERAL INFORMATION

The Graveley & McIntosh Ranches Block Management Area (BMA) is located in Powell County northeast of Avon. Hunting on 10,877 acres is provided by private landowners, Montana Department of Natural Resources & Conservation (DNRC) and the Bureau of Land Management (BLM).

This BMA offers hunting opportunities for white-tailed deer, mule deer, elk, black bear, moose, wolf, and mountain grouse.

PERMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Every hunter is required to register *daily* at one of the sign-in boxes *before* beginning to hunt on this BMA. Registration details are posted on site at each sign-in box.

Every hunter must carry the daily permission coupon at all times while hunting on this BMA.

HOW TO GET THERE

→ Threemile Creek Road leads to US Forest Service Road #136, which accesses National Forest land in the Ophir Creek area. From MT Highway 141 drive northeasterly on Threemile Road. Continue onto USFS Road #136 for 5 miles to the BMA sign-in box; **or** 5.6 miles to Carpenter Creek Road, turn right (southeast) onto Carpenter Creek Road and proceed 0.6 mile to the BMA sign-in box and northern access road.

→ Snowshoe Creek Road: from US Highway 12 west of Elliston drive northeasterly on the Snowshoe Creek Road about 2.5 miles to the BMA boundary and sign-in box.

REGULATIONS

1. Motorized vehicle travel is not allowed on this BMA. Non-motorized travel is open only to foot, horseback and non-motorized bicycle. Be prepared to retrieve game by non-motorized methods.
2. Do not park vehicles in such a manner as to obstruct traffic. Do not block gates.
3. Be aware that cattle are present on this BMA. Temporary safety zones may be created around low-elevation pastures.
4. No camping and no open fires on this BMA.
5. It is unlawful to commercially outfit on this BMA.
6. BLM lands identified on the accompanying map are not included in this BMA or subject to BMA rules.
7. Failure to abide by the regulations for these BMAs can result in a trespass violation under MCA 45-6-203 and/or a violation of FWP Department or Commission orders or rules under MCA 87-6-201.


