## GENERAL INFORMATION

This Block Management Area (BMA) is located in Granite County, about 3 miles south of Drummond and 4 miles north of Hall. Hunting on this BMA is provided by private landowners on approximately 2,400 acres.

This BMA offers hunting opportunities for elk, white-tailed deer, mule deer, black bear, wolf and upland birds.

The Dingwall Ranch strongly encourages hunters to harvest antlerless elk on this BMA.

**ELK RIFLE HUNTING ALLOWED FROM SEPTEMBER 1, 2016 – JANUARY 1, 2017.**

## PERMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Verbal permission is required at least **48 hours in advanced** to hunt on this BMA. Permission will be given on a first come first serve basis. Hunting access is limited to (5) hunters per day. Preference will be given to Elk B (antlerless) license holders.

To receive permission call the Dingwall Ranch during reasonable hours; (406) 288-3572.

After receiving verbal permission, **every hunter is required to register daily** at one of the sign-in boxes before beginning to hunt. Every hunter must carry the daily permission coupon at all times while hunting on this BMA.

## HOW TO GET THERE

From Interstate Highway 90:

Take Drummond exit #153 and travel south on Montana Highway 1 for approximately 2.7 miles to Mullan Road—

➔ Turn east onto Mullan Road and go about 1.4 miles to western boundary of the BMA.

➔ Continue onto East Mullan Trail for 1.8 miles to the ranch headquarters.

## REGULATIONS

1. Hunters are required to park and walk-in from **DESIGNATED PARKING AREAS**. Unless directed otherwise by ranch personnel.
2. Hunters must follow detailed instructions from the landowner to hunt this BMA.
3. Motorized vehicle travel is not allowed on this BMA while hunting. Be prepared to park and walk.
4. Be prepared to retrieve game by non-motorized methods.
5. Do not park vehicles in such a manner as to obstruct traffic. Do not block gates.
6. Hunters need to use caution and be aware of livestock, ranch personnel and ranch equipment within the BMA boundary.
7. Camping is NOT allowed on this BMA.
8. It is unlawful to commercially outfit on this BMA.
9. Failure to abide by the regulations for these BMAs can result in a trespass violation under MCA 45-6-203 and/or a violation of FWP Department or Commission orders or rules under MCA 87-6-201.


