## GENERAL INFORMATION

Warm Springs Creek Block Management Area (BMA) is located in Powell County about 70 miles east of Missoula and 40 miles west of Helena by road. Hunting on 28,895 acres is provided by private landowners and Montana Department of Natural Resources & Conservation (DNRC).

This BMA offers hunting opportunities for elk, mule deer, white-tailed deer, antelope, black bear, wolf and mountain grouse.

## PERMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Permission is not required to hunt on this BMA.

## HOW TO GET THERE

### **From Interstate 90 (I-90) at Phosphate Exit #170:**

➔ Proceed north to remain on Brock Creek Road to access the western part of the BMA.

➔ Drive 1.5 miles southeast on the frontage road to Warm Springs Creek Road to access the central part of the BMA.

### **From Garrison (on US Highway 12):**

➔ Proceed northeast on US Highway 12 about 6 miles to the county road (Old Highway 10) to access the Homestead Gulch area near the *Little Blackfoot Fishing Access Site*.

### **From Avon (on US Highway 12):**

Proceed north on Montana Highway #141 for:

➔ 3 miles to the Gimlet Creek Road, to access the east-central part of the BMA.

➔ 1/4 mile past the Gimlet Creek Road to an unmarked road, to access the Graveley Mine area.

➔ approximately 6 miles to mile marker #6 to the BMA sign-in box at the locked gate.

## REGULATIONS

1. Motorized vehicle travel on this BMA is only allowed on designated "Access Routes" or public roads shown on the accompanying map. Non-motorized hunting access is only open to foot, horseback or non-motorized bicycle.

Access by horse or pack stock is not allowed from Brock Creek or Warm Springs Creek without landowner permission.

2. Be prepared to retrieve game by non-motorized methods. However, motorized travel will be allowed behind some gates in the Avon area for game retrieval. Notice will be posted on gates where motorized game retrieval is allowed.

3. Do not park vehicles in such a manner as to obstruct traffic or block any gate.

4. Camping: You are required to have verbal or written landowner permission if you wish to camp on private lands within the Warm Springs BMA. .

Camping is not allowed on private land in the Brock Creek or Warm Springs Creek portions of this BMA.

Camping on DNRC Lands is allowed; consult DNRC's "Guide to Recreational Use of Montana's State Trust Lands."

5. Hunters using horses and pack stock are required to use certified weed free hay on this BMA.

6. It is unlawful to commercially outfit on this BMA.

7. Failure to abide by the regulations for this BMA can result in a trespass violation under MCA 45-6-203 and/or a violation of FWP Department or Commission orders or rules under MCA 87-6-201.


