GENERAL INFORMATION

The Dunkleberg Block Management Area (BMA) is located about 3 miles south of Drummond and 2 miles east of Hall, in Granite County. Hunting on 15,191 acres is provided by private landowners and the Department of Natural Resources and Conservation (DNRC).

This BMA offers hunting opportunities for elk, mule deer, white-tailed deer, black bear, wolf and upland game birds.

PORTIONS OF THIS BMA ARE OPEN TO ELK RIFLE HUNTING SEPTEMBER 1, 2016 – JANUARY 1, 2017. SEE ATTACHED MAP FOR EXCLUSIONS.

PERMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Every hunter is required to register daily at one of the sign-in boxes before beginning to hunt on this BMA. Registration details are posted on site at each sign-in box. (Excluding the DNRC ¾ Section 36)

Every hunter must carry the daily permission coupon at all times while hunting on this BMA.

GENERAL SEASON ACCESS RESTRICTIONS:

October 22 – November 27, 2016

THE ENTIRE DUNKLEBERG BMA IS CLOSED TO HUNTING MONDAY, TUESDAY & WEDNESDAY.
(Including the DNRC ¾ section).

THE EASTERN PORTION OF THIS BMA IS CLOSED TO HUNTING UNTIL 12:00 NOON DAILY

DNRC ¾ SECTION #36 HUNTERS ARE REQUIRED TO PARK AT THE DESIGNATED PARKING AREA ALONG DUNKLEBERG CREEK ROAD. ONLY ONE (1) VEHICLE IS ALLOWED AT THE DESIGNATED PARKING AREA with a maximum of two (2) adults. There is no limit on the number of youth hunters that can accompany an adult.

If there is a vehicle at the designated parking area, then further hunter access to this BMA is denied until the vehicle has left. No overnight parking.

HOW TO GET THERE

From Interstate Highway 90:

▶ Take **Drummond exit #153** and travel south on Montana Highway 1 for approximately:

▶ 6.5 miles to Hall; turn east onto unmarked *New Chicago Road* and continue about 2 miles. Veer right (southeast) to continue onto the *Cut Off Road*; proceed about 1 mile to the BMA boundary.

▶ 9 miles to Douglas Creek Road (east), which provides access the southern portions of the BMA.

▶ Take **Jens exit #162**; proceed south across the Clark Fork River and turn right onto *Dunkleberg Creek Road*; go southwest about 4 miles and take a sharp right turn (west) onto the unmarked "Cut-off road" (see attached map). Proceed approximately ½ mile to the BMA boundary.

REGULATIONS

1. Motorized vehicle travel is only allowed on roads shown as "public road" or "access road" on the attached map. Hunters should park vehicles along designated open roads and walk-in. Access is only open to travel on foot, horseback or non-motorized mountain bike.
2. Do not park any vehicle in such a manner as to obstruct traffic or block any gate.
3. Do not enter or shoot into any *Safety Zone*. There may be *Safety Zones* posted that are not indicated on the attached map.
4. Be aware of livestock within the BMA.
5. Camping is not allowed on this BMA.
6. It is unlawful to commercially outfit on this BMA.
7. Failure to abide by the regulations for this BMA can result in a trespass violation under MCA 45-6-203 and/or a violation of FWP Department or Commission orders or rules under MCA 87-6-201.






Dunkleberg BMA #41
