GENERAL INFORMATION

The Hollenback Ranch Block Management Area (BMA) is located in Powell County, about 60 miles east of Missoula and 60 miles west of Helena. Hunting on 3,680 acres in this BMA is provided by the Hollenback Ranch and Montana Department of Natural Resources and Conservation (DNRC).

This BMA offers hunting opportunities for elk, mule deer, white-tailed deer, black bear, wolf and mountain grouse.

ELK RIFLE HUNTING IS ALLOWED FROM SEPTEMBER 1 – JANUARY 1.

PERMISSION REQUIREMENTS

EARLY SEASON (ARCHERY & ELK RIFLE):

September 1 – October 21

Written permission is required to hunt this BMA during this period. To receive written permission call (406) 288-3382 or stop by the Hollenback Ranch residence (yellow house near the Gold Creek Post Office; west side of the road) during reasonable hours to obtain written permission.

GENERAL & LATE ELK RIFLE SEASONS:

October 22 – January 1

Before hunting, each hunter is required to fill out a season-long permission coupon at the sign-in box (see accompanying map). Each hunter must then carry their completed permission coupon at all times while hunting.

HOW TO GET THERE

From Drummond (exit #153), travel east on Interstate Highway 90 (I-90) to:

→ Gold Creek Exit #166: Drive 1 mile west along the frontage road to Gough Creek Road;

→ Drive north on Gough Creek Road about 1 mile to the self-service permission box for the Hollenback BMA (see accompanying map).

REGULATIONS

1. Motorized vehicle travel on this BMA is only allowed on Gough Creek Road and designated access routes. Travel off-road or on closed roads is open only to foot, horse or non-motorized bicycle. Hunters should park along open roads and be prepared to retrieve game by non-motorized methods.
2. Do not park vehicles in such a manner as to obstruct traffic or block any gate.
3. Camping is allowed on the Hollenback Ranch, but you must first contact the landowner for permission. At your campsite, you must place, in writing and in a visible manner, the name, address and phone numbers of the occupant(s) of the site.

Camping on DNRC Lands is allowed; consult DNRC's "Guide to Recreational Use of Montana's State Trust Lands." It is unlawful to commercially outfit on this BMA.
4. Failure to abide by these regulations can result in a trespass violation under MCA 45-6-203 and/or a violation of FWP Dept. or Commission orders or rules under MCA 87-6-201.


