GENERAL INFORMATION

The Perkins Ranch Block Management Area (BMA) is located in Powell County about 14 miles southwest of Deer Lodge. Hunting on about 1,760 acres is provided by a private landowner.

This BMA offers hunting opportunities for white-tailed deer, elk, mule deer, black bear, wolf and upland game birds. Advance permission is not required to hunt this BMA, however, hunter registration is required and each hunter must carry a season-long permission coupon while hunting this BMA.

ELK RIFLE HUNTING ALLOWED FROM OCTOBER 22, 2016 – JANUARY 1, 2017.

PERMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Prior to the first day of hunting on this BMA, every hunter is required to register at one of the sign-in boxes by filling out a season-long permission coupon. Registration details are posted on site at each sign-in box.

Every hunter must carry the season-long permission coupon at all times while hunting on this BMA. The permission coupon is valid on this BMA from September 1, 2016 through January 1, 2017.

HOW TO GET THERE

From Interstate Highway 90, take Deer Lodge exit #187;

➔ Drive south on either the frontage road or Greenhouse Road about 4 miles to Sager Lane;

➔ Drive west on Sager Lane for 1.2 miles to Yellowstone Trail;

➔ Drive south on Yellowstone Trail 0.2 miles to Dempsey Lake Road;

➔ Drive southeasterly on Dempsey Lake Road for 3.8 miles to Perkins Road;

➔ Drive northwest on Perkins Road about 3 miles to the ranch headquarters.

REGULATIONS

1. Motorized vehicle travel is not allowed on this BMA.
2. Non-motorized travel is open only to travel on foot, horseback or non-motorized bicycle.
3. Do not block any gate or park any vehicle in such a manner that obstructs traffic.
4. Leave gates as you found them.
5. Camping is not allowed on this BMA.
6. It is unlawful to commercially outfit on this BMA.
7. Failure to abide by the regulations for this BMA can result in a trespass violation under MCA 45-6-203 and/or a violation of FWP Department or Commission orders or rules under MCA 87-6-201.




