## GENERAL INFORMATION

This Block Management Area (BMA) is located in Powell County about 8 miles southeast of Deer Lodge. Hunting on 2,144 acres is provided by private landowners and Montana Department of Natural Resources and Conservation (DNRC).

This BMA offers hunting opportunities for elk, mule deer, white-tailed deer, antelope, black bear, wolf and mountain grouse.

**PORTIONS OF THIS BMA ARE OPEN TO ELK RIFLE HUNTING SEPTEMBER 1, 2016 – JANUARY 1, 2017. SEE ATTACHED MAP FOR EXCLUSIONS.**

\*Burnt Hollow Ranch is NOT participating in Elk Shoulder Seasons through the Block Management Program. (Sections 29, a portion of 5, 6 & 31)

## PERMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Every hunter is required to register *daily* at one of the sign-in boxes *before* beginning to hunt on this BMA. Registration details are posted on-site at each sign-in box.

Every hunter must carry the daily permission coupon at all times while hunting on this BMA.

## HOW TO GET THERE

From Interstate Highway 90 at Deer Lodge, take exit #184 to Boulder Road (east side of I-90).

➔ Proceed on the Boulder Road about 10 miles southeast to Spring-Emery Road (USFS Road #1504).

➔ Sign-in boxes are located on Spring-Emery Road and USFS Road #5170. Access the BMA from sign-in box locations and through Forest Service land.

## REGULATIONS

1. Motorized vehicle travel is only allowed on public or designated access roads on the accompanying map. Travel on other roads, as well as off-road travel, is restricted to foot, horseback or non-motorized bicycle.
2. **September 3 – November 27 (ONLY)**  
Motorized game retrieval is allowed on existing well established ranch roads from the green gate at the western end of USFS Road #5170.  
Abuse of this privilege will result in locked gates and loss of motorized retrieval access.
3. Do not park any vehicle in such a manner as to obstruct traffic or block any gate.
4. **Cattle will be present during archery and rifle seasons. Ranch personnel will also be present on a daily basis attending to their livestock.**
5. Camping and fires are NOT allowed on private land in this BMA. Camping on DNRC Lands is allowed; consult DNRC's "Guide to Recreational Use of Montana's State Trust Lands."
6. No firewood or Christmas tree cutting.
7. It is unlawful to commercially outfit on this BMA.
8. Failure to abide by the regulations for this BMA can result in a trespass violation under MCA 45-6-203 and/or a violation of FWP Department or Commission orders or rules under MCA 87-6-201.


