GENERAL INFORMATION

The Upper Clark Fork River Block Management Area (BMA) is located approximately 15 miles south of Deer Lodge. Hunting on 13,110 acres is provided by multiple private landowners and Montana Department of Natural Resources & Conservation (DNRC).

This BMA provides hunting opportunities for white-tailed deer, mule deer, antelope, elk, black bear, upland bird and waterfowl.

ELK RIFLE HUNTING ALLOWED FROM SEPTEMBER 1, 2016 – JANUARY 1, 2017.

PERMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Prior to the first day of hunting on the Upper Clark Fork River BMA, every hunter is required to register by filling out a season-long permission coupon at one of the sign-in boxes. Registration details are posted on-site at each sign-in boxes.

Every hunter must carry their season-long permission coupon at all times while hunting on this BMA. Permission coupons are valid from September 1, 2016 through January 18, 2017.

HOW TO GET THERE

From Interstate Highway 90, take Galen exit #197; drive east on the Galen Road about 1 mile (crossing the Clark Fork River) to the Eastside Road:

➡ Turn north onto the Eastside Road to access the Deer Lodge River, Dry Cottonwood Creek, and Beck Ranches

➡ Turn south onto the Eastside Road to access the Deer Lodge River, Lampert, and Logan Ranches.

RANCH ACCESS

Beck Ranch: Hunting access is walk-in only from Eastside or Sand Hollow Roads. Vehicle access for game retrieval may be allowed by contacting the landowner.

Deer Lodge River Ranch: Hunting access is walk-in only from the Eastside, Dry Cottonwood Creek or Galen Roads. Vehicle access for game retrieval may be allowed by contacting the landowner.

Dry Cottonwood Creek Ranch: Hunting access is walk-in only from county roads.

Lampert Ranch: Non-motorized hunting is open only to foot, horseback or non-motorized bicycle. Hunters should park vehicles along county roads. Motorized game retrieval may be allowed with permission from the Lampert Ranch by calling (406) 691-0847.

Logan Ranch: Hunting access in the Logan Ranch portion of the BMA is walk-in only, from one of the two designated parking areas.

REGULATIONS

- RIFLE USE IS PROHIBITED ON THE LOGAN RANCH;** hunting with archery equipment, shotgun, muzzleloader or traditional handgun is allowed on the Logan Ranch.
- DO NOT BLOCK GATES.
- Black bear hunting is not allowed on the Dry Cottonwood Creek Ranch (DCCR).
- Cattle may be present on multiple portions on this BMA, please use caution.
- Do not enter or shoot into *Safety Zones*. Keep clear of residences and ranch buildings.
- No camping or campfires allowed on this BMA.
- It is unlawful to commercially outfit on this BMA.
- Failure to abide by the regulations for this BMA can result in a trespass violation under MCA 45-6-203 and/or a violation of FWP Department or Commission orders or rules under MCA 87-6-201.


