GENERAL INFORMATION

The Ueland Ranch & Atlantic Richfield Company (ARCO) Block Management Area (BMA) is located about 3 miles northeast of Anaconda. Hunting on 9,224 acres is provided by private landowners.

This BMA offers hunting opportunities for white-tailed deer, mule deer, elk, black bear, moose, sandhill crane, wolf, upland game birds and waterfowl.

ELK RIFLE HUNTING ALLOWED FROM OCTOBER 22, 2016 – JANUARY 1, 2017.

PERMISSION REQUIREMENTS

UPLAND BIRD, WATERFOWL AND ARCHERY BIG GAME HUNTERS:

Every hunter must register daily at one of the sign-in boxes before beginning to hunt on the BMA. Registration details are posted on site at each sign-in box. Every hunter must carry their daily permission coupon at all times while hunting on this BMA.

BIG GAME RIFLE HUNTERS DURING THE GENERAL RIFLE SEASON:

October 22nd – November 27th, 2016

Written permission is required to hunt on this BMA, and hunter numbers are limited. Reservations for written permission will be issued on a first-come, first-served basis by calling the Region 2 Hunting Access Office (406)542-5530. Reservations will begin **Tuesday, October 4 at 12 noon** and will continue Monday-Friday, 8 am - 5 pm.

► Hunter numbers are limited to 16 per hunt period.

► Hunters may only reserve one hunt period at a time, and may not make further reservations until they have completed that hunting period.

► Each hunter must carry their permission slip on them while hunting on this BMA.

ANTLERLESS ELK RIFLE HUNTERS FROM DECEMBER 1ST 2016 TO JANUARY 1ST 2017:

Every hunter must register daily at one of the sign-in boxes before beginning to hunt on the BMA. Registration details are posted on site at each sign-in box. Every hunter must carry their daily permission coupon at all times while hunting on this BMA.

HOW TO GET THERE

From Interstate Highway 90 northwest of Butte: Take the Galen exit #197 and access the BMA via Montana Highway 273, or take Warm Springs exit #201 (off I-90) and access the BMA via Montana Highway 48.

REGULATIONS

1. All access is walk-in only from designated parking areas, Montana Highway # 48 or # 273.
2. Motorized vehicle travel is only allowed on roads shown as Access Roads on the accompanying map.
3. Hunters should be prepared to retrieve their game by non-motorized methods.
4. Do not park vehicles in such a manner as to obstruct traffic or block any gate. Gates should be left as found (i.e., gates found open should be left open; gates found closed should be left closed).
5. Hunting is not allowed when cattle are present.
6. Camping is not allowed.
7. It is unlawful to commercially outfit on this BMA.
8. Failure to abide by the regulations for this BMA can result in a trespass violation under MCA 45-6-203 and/or a violation of FWP Department or Commission orders or rules under MCA 87-6-201.


