## GENERAL INFORMATION

The Spring Creek Block Management Area (BMA) is located in Granite County about 19 miles west, then south by road from Philipsburg. Hunting on about 5,104 acres is provided by private landowners.

The Spring Creek BMA offers hunting opportunities for elk, mule deer, white-tailed deer, moose\*, black bear, wolf, and mountain grouse. \*Only bull moose may be harvested.

**ELK RIFLE HUNTING IS ALLOWED  
SEPTEMBER 1, 2016 – JANUARY 1, 2017.**

## PERMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Every hunter is required to register daily at one of the sign-in boxes before beginning to hunt on this BMA.

Registration details are posted on site at each sign-in box. Every hunter must carry the daily permission coupon at all times while hunting on this BMA.

## HOW TO GET THERE

From Interstate 90 near Drummond (50 miles east of Missoula) take Drummond exit #153:

- ➔ Head south on Montana Highway #1 about 26 miles to Route #348 (west of Philipsburg).
- ➔ Proceed west on Route #348 about 10 miles to the northern boundary.
- ➔ Continue west on Route #348 for 5 miles to the junction with Rock Creek Road #102; turn left and continue on Route #348 for 1 mile, which runs south up Rock Creek to the southwestern boundary.

## REGULATIONS

1. Motorized travel is not allowed on this BMA. Access is walk-in only.
2. Hunters should park vehicles at **designated parking areas** or along public roads designated open on the accompanying map.
3. Do not park vehicles in such a manner as to obstruct traffic. Do not block gates and please leave gates how you found them.
4. Motorized game retrieval may be allowed with permission from ranch personnel.
5. Snowmobile access is permitted for game retrieval from December 1 – January 1. It is not necessary to contact ranch personnel when using a snowmobile during these dates.
6. No camping & no fires on this BMA.
7. It is unlawful to commercially outfit on this BMA.
8. Failure to abide by the regulations for this BMA can result in a trespass violation under MCA 45-6-203 and/or a violation of FWP Department or Commission orders or rules under MCA 87-6-201.


