GENERAL INFORMATION

The Black Pine Ridge Block Management Area (BMA) is located in Granite County west of Philipsburg. Hunting on 6,600 acres is provided by private landowners and Montana Department of Natural Resources and Conservation (DNRC). This BMA also provides access to adjacent state and federal lands.

This BMA offers hunting opportunities for elk, mule deer, white-tailed deer, moose, black bear, wolf and mountain grouse.

ONLY HUNTING DISTRICT 210 PORTIONS OF THIS BMA ARE OPEN TO ELK RIFLE HUNTING SEPTEMBER 1, 2016 – JANUARY 1, 2017.

PERMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Permission is not required to hunt on this BMA, and access is by non-motorized methods.

Five Vehicle Sign-in: the private road labeled “Access Road” on the accompanying map is open for motorized travel. Drive-in access on this road is limited to 5 vehicles daily, and hunters must register at the sign-in box at the green gate on Route # 348 before driving on the access road.

NO OVERNIGHT PARKING

If 5 vehicles have already signed in for the day, then all further access along this road must be by non-motorized methods for that day. **This portion of the BMA and “access road” is CLOSED to all access November 21-27, 2016.***

HOW TO GET THERE

From Interstate Highway 90 (I-90), take Drummond exit #153:

➔Head south from Drummond on Montana Highway 1 about 26 miles to Route # 348 (west of Philipsburg);

➔Go west on Route # 348 about 8 miles to the private access road to get to the southeastern portion of the BMA or continue on Route # 348 to

Upper Willow Creek Road (USFS Road #88) to access the northwest portions of the BMA.

REGULATIONS

1. **The portion of Black Pine Ridge BMA south of Route #348 is CLOSED November 21 – 27 2016.***
2. Hunters should park vehicles along designated “access roads” on the accompanying map to access this BMA. Non-motorized access is open only to foot, horseback, or non-motorized bicycle. (See 5 Vehicle Sign-In exception)
3. Do not park any vehicle in such a manner as to obstruct traffic. Do not block any gate.
4. Some of Black Pine Ridge BMA cooperating landowners will allow vehicle access for game retrieval purposes. Hunters may receive permission for vehicle access for game retrieval, by contacting the appropriate private landowner after they have game down.
5. Camping on private lands is permitted with landowner permission.
6. It is unlawful to commercially outfit on this BMA.
7. Failure to abide by the regulations for this BMA can result in a trespass violation under MCA 45-6-203 and/or a violation of FWP Department or Commission orders or rules under MCA 87-6-201.


