GENERAL INFORMATION

The Johnson Tuning Fork Ranch Block Management Area (BMA) is located in Granite County north of Philipsburg. Hunting on about 3,750 acres is provided by a private landowner and Montana Department of Natural Resources and Conservation (DNRC). This BMA also provides access to adjacent state and federal lands.

This BMA offers hunting opportunities for elk, mule deer, white-tailed deer, moose, black bear, wolf and mountain grouse.

**ELK RIFLE HUNTING IS ONLY ALLOWED
OCTOBER 22 – NOVEMBER 27.**

PERMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Permission is not required to hunt on this BMA.

HOW TO GET THERE

From Interstate Highway 90 (I-90), take Drummond exit #153. Head south on Montana Highway 1 to:

→ Forest Service (USFS) Road # 1501 junction about 2 miles north of Maxville at milepost 50; take # 1501 southwest for 5.9 miles to the gate at the northeast corner of the BMA.

→ Parking area at USFS Road # 1539 (Sawmill Creek) junction at the bridge and corrals. Road #1539 provides access to the central and north portions of the BMA.

→ Black Pine Road # 448: continue on # 448 to USFS Road # 5198, then to USFS Road # 78505 to reach the western boundary.

REGULATIONS

1. Hunters should park vehicles along designated access roads on accompanying map. Access to this BMA is by non-motorized methods open only to foot, horseback, or non-motorized bicycle.
2. Do not park any vehicle in such a manner as to obstruct traffic or block any gate.
3. Camping on private lands is permitted with landowner permission. Camping on State School Trust Lands is allowed; consult DNRC's "Guide to Recreational Use of Montana's State Trust Lands."
4. It is unlawful to commercially outfit on this BMA.
5. Failure to abide by the regulations for this BMA can result in a trespass violation under MCA 45-6-203 and/or a violation of FWP Department or Commission orders or rules under MCA 87-6-201.


