GENERAL INFORMATION

The Antelope Gulch Block Management Area (BMA) is located in Deer Lodge County about 6 miles north of Anaconda. Hunting on 450 acres is provided by a private landowner.

This BMA offers hunting opportunities for mule deer, white-tailed deer, elk, black bear, wolf and mountain grouse, as well as non-motorized access to adjacent state and federal land.

ELK RIFLE HUNTING ALLOWED FROM OCTOBER 22, 2016 – JANUARY 1, 2017.

PERMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Prior to the first day of hunting on Antelope Gulch BMA, every hunter is required to register by filling out a season-long permission coupon at one of the sign-in boxes. Registration details are posted on-site at each sign-in boxes.

Every hunter must carry their season-long permission coupon at all times while hunting on this BMA. Permission coupons are valid from September 1, 2016 through January 18, 2017.

A maximum of **2 vehicles** are allowed at the **designated parking area** at any time. If there are 2 vehicles at the parking area, then further hunter access to this BMA is denied until at least one of the vehicles has left. Vehicles must be parked in a manner so as not to obstruct roadways or gates for landowner access.

HOW TO GET THERE

From the junction of Montana Highways 1 and 48 (about 2 miles east of Anaconda), take Highway 48 about ¼ mile northeast to the junction with Route 273.

➔Take Route 273 about 4.5 miles north to the Spring Gulch-Road; veer left onto that road and proceed about 0.8 mile northwest to the Antelope Gulch Road.

➔Turn left onto that road and proceed 1.1 miles west to the BMA parking area and sign-in box.

REGULATIONS

1. Hunters are required to park at the **designated parking area** at the sign-in box on Antelope Gulch Road. When parking vehicles, do not park in such a manner as to obstruct traffic or block any gate.
2. Motorized vehicle travel is not allowed on this BMA. Non-motorized travel is open only to foot, horseback or non-motorized bicycle.
3. Camping is not allowed on this BMA.
4. It is unlawful to commercially outfit on this BMA.
5. Failure to abide by the regulations for this BMA can result in a trespass violation under MCA 45-6-203 and/or a violation of FWP Department or Commission orders or rules under MCA 87-6-201.


