**Hunting Access Dates:** September 1 - November 27, 2016

## GENERAL INFORMATION

The Stimson-Horsefly Creek Block Management Area (BMA) is located east of Lincoln in Lewis and Clark County. Hunting on 4,055 acres is provided by Stimson Lumber Company.

This BMA offers hunting opportunities for elk, mule deer, white-tailed deer, moose, black bear, wolf and mountain grouse. It also provides access to adjacent state and federal lands.

## PERMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Permission is not required to hunt on this BMA.

## HOW TO GET THERE

From Missoula:

- ▶ Drive east on Hwy 200 approximately 83 miles to Hwy 279.
- ▶ Turn right on Hwy 279 to access the BMA.

From Helena:

- ▶ Drive northwest on Hwy 279 approximately 35 miles to access the BMA on both sides of the road.

## REGULATIONS

1. Motorized vehicle travel is not allowed on this BMA. Non-motorized hunting travel is open only to foot, horseback or non-motorized bicycle.
2. Do not block gates.
3. Camping is not allowed on this BMA.
4. No fires allowed.
5. No wood cutting.
6. No littering.
7. It is unlawful to commercially outfit on this BMA.
8. Failure to abide by the regulations for this BMA can result in a trespass violation under MCA 45-6-203 and/or a violation of FWP Department or Commission orders or rules under MCA 87-6-201.


