## GENERAL INFORMATION

The Keep Cool Hills Block Management Area (BMA) is located in Lewis and Clark County, a few miles northeast of Lincoln. Hunting on 14,500 acres is provided by the Sieben Ranch Company, Montana Department of Natural Resources and Conservation (DNRC) and Montana Nature Conservancy (TNC).

Hunting opportunities exist for white-tailed deer, mule deer, elk, moose, mountain lion, black bear, wolf and mountain grouse, as well as access to adjacent state and federal lands.

## PERMISSION REQUIREMENTS

No permission is required to access this area.

## REGULATIONS

1. Motorized wheeled-vehicle travel is NOT allowed except on the public roadways and designated access routes shown on the accompanying map.

2. Landowners, federal, state and county officials in the course of their official duties are exempt from vehicle restrictions.

3. Do not park vehicles in such a manner as to block roads or gates.

### 4. **CAMPING RESTRICTIONS:**

▶ Camping on Sieben Ranch Company lands is limited to one of the **designated camping areas** on the accompanying map. (Sucker & Copper Creek Junction or Keep Cool Lakes)

▶ Camping is allowed on Nature Conservancy lands posted on site as **designated camping areas**.

▶ Camping on DNRC lands is limited to one of the **designated camping areas** on the accompanying map. (South Landers Fork or North Landers Fork / South Copper Creek Road)

All camping is limited to a total of not more than 16 days during any 28-day period. Both the 16-day and the 28-day periods start the first day the camp and/or camp gear is on-site. Following the 16-day camping period, persons may not relocate a camp within the Keep Cool Hills BMA until the 28-day period has lapsed. Upon the end of the 16-day period, all camps must be completely removed.

### 6. **MANDATORY FOOD STORAGE ORDER:**

To minimize conflicts with bears: Human, pet and livestock food, beverages, garbage, game meat, carcass parts and all other attractants shall be stored at all times in accordance with FWP's Wildlife Management Area Food Storage Order, available at [fwp.mt.gov](http://fwp.mt.gov). Attractants shall not be buried, discarded or burned in an open campfire.

5. Hunters using horses and pack stock are required to use certified weed-free hay in this BMA.

6. Target shooting with firearms is prohibited on Sieben Ranch Company land.

7. Wood cutting or gathering is prohibited on Sieben Ranch Company land.

8. Do not enter DNRC cabin site leases or shoot into Safety (No Trespassing) Zones. There may be safety zones posted on site that are not shown on the accompanying map.

9. Commercial outfitting is prohibited.

10. Failure to abide by these regulations can result in a trespass violation under MCA45-6-203 and/or a violation of FWP Department or Commission orders or rules under MCA 87-6-203. Repeat offenders can be denied future access privileges.


