**Hunting Districts:** D/E 390 & 391, Ant 390, BMU 440

**Township/Range:** T5N-R5E, T6N-R5E, T6N-T3E & T6N-R2E

**Huntible Game:** Elk, Mule Deer, White-tailed Deer, Black Bear; Upland Bird, Moose & Antelope

**Dates BMA is open:** Legal Fall Hunting Seasons for Elk, Mule Deer, White-tailed Deer, Black Bear, Upland Birds (see map), Moose & Antelope. **\*Elk hunting allowed 9/3/16-1/1/17 only.** Refer to current hunting regulations for specific season information.

**Maps to have before you go:** This BMA Map, available free at Butte, Bozeman & Helena Area FWP offices, **AND** the BLM 100K Townsend, available for purchase through any Forest Service or Bozeman & Helena Area FWP offices.

**Road Use:** Vehicle travel permitted only on designated roads. Please refer to the BLM 100K Townsend for road use information on all roads outside of block management area boundaries.

**How to get there:** Travel south of Townsend for about 6 miles on Hwy 287. Turn East on Nelson/Dry Creek Road to BMA.


## **Ranch Rules:**

- Walk-in hunting from designated roads. No off road vehicle travel.
- Every hunter must sign-in at roster box each day before they hunt.
- No camping. No campfires.
- Please leave gates as you found them.
- Upland bird hunting allowed only on portions of BMA and bird numbers may be limited (see map).
- Some roads will be restricted to 4-wheeler travel only.
- **Non Motorized Access is allowed through this BMA to DNRC T6N-R2E-S36**
- **State School Trust Land rules apply. Motorized vehicle use of roads on state land enrolled in BMA's shall be conducted in compliance with provisions and rules established in the BMA, except that off-road use is prohibited. This authorization is granted only for the dates in which the BMA is in effect. Upon termination or expiration of the BMA and for periods in which the BMA is not in effect, or at such times as DNRC may deem this authorization no longer appropriate, motorized vehicle use of roads on state land for general recreational purposes shall be conducted subject to the provisions of ARM 36.25.149.**
