Township/Range: T8N-R2E & T8N-R3E

Huntible Game: Elk, Mule Deer, White-tailed Deer, Antelope, Fall Turkey; Upland Birds; Fall Black Bear & Waterfowl

Dates BMA is open: Legal Fall Hunting Seasons for Elk, Mule Deer, White-tailed Deer, Antelope, Fall Turkey; Upland Birds; Fall Black Bear & Waterfowl. Refer to current hunting regulations for specific season information.

Maps to have before you go: This BMA Map, available free at Butte, Bozeman & Helena Area FWP offices, **AND** the Helena National Forest, available for purchase through any Forest Service or Bozeman & Helena Area FWP offices.

Road Use: Vehicle travel permitted only on designated roads. Please refer to the Helena National Forest for road use information on all roads outside of block management area boundaries.

How to get there: Travel north of Townsend on Hwy 284 for approximately 11 miles to the Lower Duck Creek Turnoff.


Ranch Rules:

- Walk-in hunting from designated roads. No off road vehicle travel.
- Hunter numbers will be limited to 12 hunters per day for the first 3 days of general rifle season (Oct 22-24). Written permission will be required from landowner to hunt those days. Permission slips will be granted at the ranch house from 6:00pm -8:00pm on the evenings of Oct 21, 22 & 23.
- Other than the first 3 days of general rifle season when written permission is required from landowner (see above), every hunter must register at sign-in box each day prior to hunting.
- Hunter signature is permission to hunt this area. See sign-in box location on map.
- Each Hunter must keep daily sign in coupon on dash while hunting.
- Please leave gates as you found them. Open or Closed
- No camping, no campfires, no littering.
- Please do not block gates.
- No shooting around livestock
- Big game retrieval may be permitted with landowner permission.
