Huntible Game: Elk & White-tailed Deer **Hunting Districts:** D/E 339 **Township/Range:** T12N-R4W

Dates BMA is open: Legal Fall Hunting Seasons for Elk & White-tailed Deer. Refer to current hunting regulations for specific season information.

Maps to have before you go: This BMA Map, available free at Butte, Bozeman & Helena Area FWP offices, **AND** the Helena National Forest Travel Plan, available for purchase through any Forest Service or Bozeman & Helena Area FWP offices.

Road Use: Vehicle travel permitted only on designated roads. Please refer to the Helena National Forest Travel Plan for road use information on all roads outside of block management area boundaries.

How to get there: BMA is located between Canyon Creek and Silver City north of Helena

Ranch Rules:

- Hunters must obtain a written permission slip to hunt this BMA. Hunters should call (800) 294-3940 between 7am-6pm on the specified Monday call-in date. Permission will be granted on a first come, first served basis to 10 hunters/time period. Remaining hunter slots available after the Monday call-in date will be filled by hunters who call in later that week. Permission slips are mailed, so please plan far enough in advance as you must have a slip in hand for access to this BMA. Permission slips cannot be obtained on site. Hunters should be prepared to provide 1st and 2nd choice of hunt dates, hunter names, ALS numbers, phone number, mailing address. Permission slips are only valid for dates and names indicated.


- Permission slips issued will have 2 parts. One portion is to be put on dashboard, and one part must be kept on you at all times while hunting. Permission slips are not valid until signed by hunter.
- There are large numbers of cattle on this property. Please be very careful of your target and keep all gates closed.
- There are heavily used roads around the perimeter of this BMA, please be careful of your target.
- Walk-in hunting from designated roads. No off road vehicle travel. Game retrieval may be permitted with landowner permission only. Please do not park in any way to obstruct traffic or block any gates. No camping and no fires.
- Hunting is not permitted on the railroad right-of-way.
- Archery hunters must attempt to locate any lost arrows.
- Please remove gut piles from fields that contain cattle or place in burn pile shown on map.
- State School Trust Land rules apply. Motorized vehicle use of roads on state land enrolled in BMA's shall be conducted in compliance with provisions and rules established in the BMA, except that off-road use is prohibited. This authorization is granted only for the dates in which the BMA is in effect. Upon termination or expiration of the BMA and for periods in which the BMA is not in effect, or at such times as DNRC may deem this authorization no longer appropriate, motorized vehicle use of roads on state land for general recreational purposes shall be conducted subject to the provisions of ARM 36.25.149.**
