**Township/Range:** T1N-R7E, T1S-R7E & T1S-R8E

**Huntible Game:** Elk\*, Mule Deer, White-Tailed Deer, Upland Birds, Moose & Fall Black Bear

**Dates BMA is open:** Legal Fall Hunting Seasons for Elk, Mule Deer, White-Tailed Deer, Upland Birds, Moose & Fall Black Bear. \*Elk hunting allowed 9/3/16-11/27/16 only. Refer to current hunting regulations for specific season information.

**Maps to have before you go:** This BMA Map, available free at Butte, Bozeman & Helena Area FWP offices, **AND** the Gallatin National Forest Travel Map (East Half 2003 or North Map 2012), available for purchase through any Forest Service or Bozeman & Helena Area FWP offices.

**Road Use:** Vehicle travel permitted only on designated roads. Please refer to the Gallatin National Forest Travel Map (East Half 2003 or North Map 2012) for road use information on all roads outside of block management area boundaries.

**How to get there:** BMA access points on Jackson Creek Rd, Stone Creek Rd and Olson Creek Rd. See map.


### **Ranch Rules:**

- Hunters must register at sign in box daily prior to hunting.
- Walk-in hunting from designated roads. No off road vehicle travel. Please do not park in any way to obstruct traffic or block any gates. No camping, no littering and no fires.
- Horseback hunting and pedal bicycles allowed.
- No motorized vehicles off designated roads. Please report violations to FWP (license plate, date, time etc.)
- Remember, hunting on this land is a privilege made possible by the voluntary cooperation of the landowner. Please do your part to take care of this land as if it were your own.
