Huntible Game: White-tailed Deer, Mule Deer, Elk, Antelope, Upland Birds

Dates BMA is open: Legal Fall Hunting Seasons for White-tailed Deer, Mule Deer, Elk, Antelope, Upland Birds. Refer to current hunting regulations for specific season information.

Maps to have before you go: This BMA Map, available free at Butte, Bozeman & Helena Area FWP offices, **AND** the Beaverhead/Deerlodge National Forest Travel Plan 2008 (North), available for purchase through any Forest Service or Bozeman & Helena Area FWP offices.

Road Use: Vehicle travel permitted only on designated roads. Please refer to the Beaverhead/Deerlodge National Forest Travel Plan 2008 (North) for road use information on all roads outside of block management area boundaries.

How to get there: Ranch is located in the Boulder Valley off HWY 69, See Map for Sign-In locations.


Ranch Rules:

- Walk-in hunting from designated roads.
- Daily Sign-In required. Written permission on site from Sign-In Box location. See map for box location. Each hunter must carry permission stub on them while hunting. Hunters who are reasonably unable to sign in daily due to camping on the USFS may sign in for multiple days.
- No motorized vehicles off designated roads.
- No Dogs in crops or near livestock - Bird Hunters may get permission to hunt near livestock/crops directly from landowner (See Ranchhouse)
- No Camping.
- Game retrieval with vehicle permitted only with landowner permission.
- Please use practices to assist with weed control.
- **State School Trust Land rules apply. Motorized vehicle use of roads on state land enrolled in BMA's shall be conducted in compliance with provisions and rules established in the BMA, except that off-road use is prohibited. This authorization is granted only for the dates in which the BMA is in effect. Upon termination or expiration of the BMA and for periods in which the BMA is not in effect, or at such times as DNRC may deem this authorization no longer appropriate, motorized vehicle use of roads on state land for general recreational purposes shall be conducted subject to the provisions of ARM 36.25.149.**

Every hunter must have permission. This includes possession of a written permission slip or signing in at a roster box **before** hunting.




XC Ranch BMA Block Management Area #126
