Road Use: Vehicle travel permitted only on designated roads. Please refer to the Beaverhead/Deerlodge National Forest Travel Plan 2008 (Central & South) for road use information on all roads outside of block management area boundaries.

How to get there: From Alder, take Upper Ruby Road for 3 1/2 miles to Judy Lane. Travel approx 1 1/4 miles on Judy Lane to access road for BMA.


Ranch Rules:

- Written Permission is required to hunt this BMA.
- Reservations will be taken and must be made at least 48 hours prior to hunt date (no last minute hunts)
- Permission times are between 7-9am and 7-9pm. Please call Dan or Janet at 842-5032.
- Walk-in hunting only from designated parking areas as signed.
- Camping permitted by written landowner permission only.
- Please be aware that there are homes adjacent to this BMA. Safety precautions must be taken.
- **State School Trust Land rules apply. Motorized vehicle use of roads on state land enrolled in BMA's shall be conducted in compliance with provisions and rules established in the BMA, except that off-road use is prohibited. This authorization is granted only for the dates in which the BMA is in effect. Upon termination or expiration of the BMA and for periods in which the BMA is not in effect, or at such times as DNRC may deem this authorization no longer appropriate, motorized vehicle use of roads on state land for general recreational purposes shall be conducted subject to the provisions of ARM 36.25.149.**




Sauerbier Ranch Block Management Area #23 Map 1 of 2


- Daily registration at sign-in box required to hunt this BMA. See sign-in box location on map.
