Huntible Game: White-tailed Deer, Mule Deer, Elk, Antelope, Moose & Upland Birds

Dates BMA is open: Legal Fall Hunting Seasons for White-tailed Deer, Mule Deer, Elk, Antelope, Moose & Upland Birds. Refer to current hunting regulations for specific season information.

Maps to have before you go: This BMA Map, available free at Butte, Bozeman & Helena Area FWP offices, **AND** the Beaverhead/Deerlodge National Forest Travel Plan 2008 (South), available for purchase through any Forest Service or Bozeman & Helena Area FWP offices.

Road Use: Vehicle travel permitted only on designated roads. Please refer to the Beaverhead/Deerlodge National Forest Travel Plan 2008 (South) for road use information on all roads outside of block management area boundaries.

How to get there: Blacktail drainage lands open 13 miles up Blacktail Road from Dillon on the South side of road as signed. Sage Creek lands accessed via Dell on the Sage Creek, Little Sage Creek and Basin Creek Roads. Centennial lands accessed via Dell or Monida on the north or south Centennial Roads.


Ranch Rules:

- No permission is required to hunt this BMA. Remember, hunting on the Matador is a privilege made possible by the voluntary cooperation of the landowner. Please do your part to take care of this land as if it were your own.
- Access to all Matador lands included in block management will be by foot or horseback, unless vehicle travel is specifically designated. All roads are subject to closure due to fire danger.
- No hunting in areas where cattle are concentrated or where the Matador has signed closed for operational reasons.

Matador Ranch Block Management Area #27 Map 1 of 2



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


