
1. Hunting opportunities exist for elk, mule deer, white-tailed deer, moose and grouse.
2. The area is open for Block Management use during legal fall hunting seasons for deer, elk, moose and upland birds. See current hunting regulations for specific season dates.
3. Access by written permission only. Reservations will be taken starting August 22nd at 7:00a.m through September 15th. Contact Cindy Block at (406) 578-2304 for permission and arrangements for access slip. Answering machines will direct you to the correct number. Access is on a first-come basis providing access to five hunting parties per day. Hunters may request specific hunting locations. **PLEASE PLACE PERMISSION SLIP FACE UP ON THE DASHBOARD OF YOUR VEHICLE WHILE HUNTING.** If your party will be using more than one vehicle, copy permission slip. No reservations will be taken after September 15th.
4. Public access and game retrieval by foot. Please park along public road right of ways and do not block gates. **NO OFF ROAD DRIVING.**
5. Please respect no shooting areas where indicated on hunting maps.
6. No hunting of black bears, lion, coyotes, or fox on private land within the BMA. Hunters are welcome to shoot badgers.
7. No smoking or fires of any kind allowed. No camping on private land in the BMA.
8. Help us catch trespassers in your hunting area. Please report open outside boundary gates, cut fences, dead livestock, and wounded or dead abandoned game animals to Mike or Cindy Block at ranch house 578-2304, or call game warden Drew Scott at 581-7613.
9. You **MUST** sign out at the end of EACH hunting day. The sign-out box is located on the rail fence past the old building just down Hill Road where the Spear Lazy U Ranch sign is located.
10. If you have a reservation and do not pick up your permission slip before your first scheduled hunt, all of your reserved days will be cancelled and you may not be given reservations in future years. Remember, permission slips are nontransferable. If you are not going to hunt with your party or are not going to hunt on a scheduled day, you **MUST** call Cindy as far in advance as possible.

At Wilsall, take the Upper Shields River Road, driving NE for 13.5 miles to the Spear Lazy U Ranch. Sign and driveway are on left side of the road before the end of the paved road.
