Hunting Districts: D/E 339 & 343, Ant 381, BMU 300

Township/Range: T12-R5W, T12-R6W, T13-R5W & T13-R6W

Dates BMA is open: Legal Fall Hunting Seasons for White-tailed Deer, Mule Deer, Elk, Antelope, Black Bear, Upland Birds & Waterfowl. Refer to current hunting regulations for specific season information.

Maps to have before you go: This BMA Map, available free at Butte, Bozeman & Helena Area FWP offices, **AND** the Helena National Forest Travel Plan, available for purchase through any Forest Service or Bozeman & Helena Area FWP offices.

Road Use: Vehicle travel permitted only on designated roads. Please refer to the Helena National Forest Travel Plan for road use information on all roads outside of block management area boundaries.

How to get there: Grady Ranch BMA - Take Hwy 279 off Lincoln interchange to the Canyon Creek Store. Continue 1.5 miles past store on Hwy 279 then turn left onto Grady Ranch BMA. Grady Livestock BMA - Take Lincoln interchange off I-15 to the Canyon Creek Store. Take Little Prickly Pear Road 1/4 mile west of Canyon Creek Store. Go 4 miles to BMA.

Grady Ranch Rules:

Huntable Game: White-tailed Deer, Mule Deer, Elk, Antelope, Black Bear, Upland Birds & Waterfowl

- Grady Ranch - No Permission required to hunt.
- Walk-in or horseback hunting from designated roads, public roads or parking area. No off road motor vehicle travel.
- No Target Practice.


Grady Livestock Rules:

- **Huntable Game:** White-tailed Deer, Mule Deer, Elk & Upland Birds
- Grady Livestock - Every hunter must register once at sign-in box each day before they hunt. Hunter signature is permission to hunt all areas of this BMA.
- Walk-in or horseback hunting from designated roads, public roads or parking area. No off road motor vehicle travel.
- No Camping. No Target Practice.
- Landowners do not forfeit any private property rights by enrolling land, including the right to deny access for just cause and the right to enforce ranch rules.
- **State School Trust Land rules apply. Motorized vehicle use of roads on state land enrolled in BMA's shall be conducted in compliance with provisions and rules established in the BMA, except that off-road use is prohibited. This authorization is granted only for the dates in which the BMA is in effect. Upon termination or expiration of the BMA and for periods in which the BMA is not in effect, or at such times as DNRC may deem this authorization no longer appropriate, motorized vehicle use of roads on state land for general recreational purposes shall be conducted subject to the provisions of ARM 36.25.149.**
