

Chevallier Ranch & Settle Ranch Block Management Area #41 & 44

Hunting Districts: D/E 339 & 343, Ant 381

Township/Range: T12N-R3W, T12N-R4W & T12N-R5W

Huntible Game: White-tailed Deer, Mule Deer, Elk, Antelope & Upland Birds

Dates BMA is open: Legal Fall Hunting Seasons for White-tailed Deer, Mule Deer, Elk, Antelope & Upland Birds. Chevallier BMA opens Sept. 1 for birds-NO ARCHERY HUNTING. Refer to current hunting regulations for specific season information.

Maps to have before you go: This BMA Map, available free at Butte, Bozeman & Helena Area FWP offices, **AND** the Helena National Forest Travel Plan, available for purchase through any Forest Service or Bozeman & Helena Area FWP offices.

Road Use: Vehicle travel permitted only on designated roads. Please refer to the Helena National Forest Travel Plan for road use information on all roads outside of block management area boundaries.

How to get there: Chevallier Ranch - Take Lincoln interchange from I-15. Head west on Hwy 279 to Silver City. Take Chevallier Drive to BMA. Settle Ranch - Take Lincoln interchange from I-15. Head west 11.5 miles on Hwy 279 (past Silver City).

Ranch Rules:


- Every hunter must register at sign-in box each day before they hunt. Hunter signature is permission to hunt this area.
- Chevallier Ranch - No motorized vehicles off designated roads. NO ARCHERY HUNTING.
- Settle Ranch - No motorized vehicles off designated roads. No Horses Allowed.
- Please be aware there is a potential to encounter unexploded ordnance (UXO) in this area from past military training activities. Although the chance is small, be aware that UXO remains in portions of the Helena Valley. If you see UXO, do not approach it, touch it, or disturb it in any way! Leave the area immediately. Call 911 to report UXO. Additional information is available at Chevallier sign-in stations. Hunters can also go to <http://www.mtarnguxoinformation.info/>
- **State School Trust Land rules apply. Motorized vehicle use of roads on state land enrolled in BMA's shall be conducted in compliance with provisions and rules established in the BMA, except that off-road use is prohibited. This authorization is granted only for the dates in which the BMA is in effect. Upon termination or expiration of the BMA and for periods in which the BMA is not in effect, or at such times as DNRC may deem this authorization no longer appropriate, motorized vehicle use of roads on state land for general recreational purposes shall be conducted subject to the provisions of ARM 36.25.149.**
