**Hunting Districts:** D/E 380, Ant 380 & BMU 301

**Township/Range:** T9N-R1W & T9N-R2W

**Huntible Game:** White-tailed Deer, Mule Deer, Elk, Antelope & Black Bear.

**Dates BMA is open:** Legal Fall Hunting Seasons for White-tailed Deer, Mule Deer, Elk, Antelope & Black Bear. Refer to current hunting regulations for specific season information.

**Maps to have before you go:** This BMA Map, available free at Butte, Bozeman & Helena Area FWP offices, **AND** the Helena National Forest Travel Plan, available for purchase through any Forest Service or Bozeman & Helena Area FWP offices.

**Road Use:** Vehicle travel permitted only on designated roads. Please refer to the Helena National Forest Travel Plan for road use information on all roads outside of block management area boundaries.

**How to get there:** Cochran Ranch - Travel 5 miles east of East Helena on Hwy 12/287. Turn South on South Mitchell Gulch to Ranch headquarters (first house on left). Potter Ranch - Travel East from East Helena on Hwy 287. Turn North between mile marker 57 and 58 to Potter Ranch Headquarters. See map for mile marker location.

## **Ranch Rules:**

- Potter Ranch - Walk-in hunting from designated roads with written permission only. Reservations will be taken for a maximum of 10 hunters per day. Hunters may get permission by contacting John Potter during daytime hours at (406) 431-1361. After 5:00p.m. try 431-1361 first or call (406) 227-6733. No calls after 9:30p.m. No Monday night calls during football season.
- Cochran Ranch - Walk-in hunting with written permission. Phone (406) 439-6270. Hunters can call to make reservations at any time. Permission limited to 3 hunters per day or 1 party of hunters. Hunters must make a reservation to hunt prior to signing in at roster box.
- No calls after 9:30p.m. No Monday night calls during football season. Every hunter must register at sign-in box each day before they hunt. Signature is part of permission requirement.
- No Upland Bird or Mountain Grouse hunting.
- Please leave gates as you found them.


