How to get there: From I-90 - Take Cardwell Exit 256; Turn North and go 0.2 miles to Cottonwood Rd.; Turn right on Cottonwood Road; Go 4.5 miles to Dawson BMA. OR - Take Hwy 69 South from Boulder to Hwy 359; Turn left and go 1.1 miles to Cottonwood Road; Turn on Cottonwood road and go 4.5 miles to Dawson BMA

Ranch Rules:


- Every hunter must register at sign-in box each day before they hunt. Hunter signature is permission to hunt this area. See map for sign-in box locations.

- Hunter access directly off I-90 not permitted.

Ranch Rules:


- Walk-in hunting from designated roads.
- Daily Sign-In required
- Written permission on site from Sign-In Box locations. See map for box location. Each hunter must carry permission stub on them while hunting.
- No motorized vehicles off designated roads.
- No Camping.
- Game retrieval with vehicle permitted only with landowner permission.
- Please use practices to assist with weed control.
- For access to section 21, hunters can contact Jack Dawson or another ranch employee at the ranch headquarters
- **State School Trust Land rules apply. Motorized vehicle use of roads on state land enrolled in BMA's shall be conducted in compliance with provisions and rules established in the BMA, except that off-road use is prohibited. This authorization is granted only for the dates in which the BMA is in effect. Upon termination or expiration of the BMA and for periods in which the BMA is not in effect, or at such times as DNRC may deem this authorization no longer appropriate, motorized vehicle use of roads on state land for general recreational purposes shall be conducted subject to the provisions of ARM 36.25.149.**
