Dates BMA is open: Legal Fall Hunting Seasons for White-tailed Deer, Mule Deer, Elk, Antelope, Black Bear, Upland Birds & Waterfowl. Refer to current hunting regulations for specific season information.

Maps to have before you go: This BMA Map, available free at Butte, Bozeman & Helena Area FWP offices, **AND** the Beaverhead/Deerlodge National Forest Travel Plan 2008 (North), available for purchase through any Forest Service or Bozeman & Helena Area FWP offices.

Road Use: Vehicle travel permitted only on designated roads. Please refer to the Beaverhead/Deerlodge National Forest Travel Plan 2008 (North) for road use information on all roads outside of block management area boundaries.

How to get there: From Whitehall, travel south on Kountz Rd. to intersection of Point Of Rocks Rd. Travel west on Point Of Rocks Rd. approx. 3 miles to ranch house on the left side of road.


Ranch Rules:

- Walk-in hunting from designated roads.
- Written permission required from ranch headquarters between 9:00a.m. and 8:00p.m.
- No off road motor vehicle travel. Vehicle undercarriage must be washed prior to accessing property
- Part of permission requirement for hunting this BMA requires hunters to return a hunter use postcard. Failure to do so may forfeit future hunting privileges on this BMA.
- Please call prior to coming out to the ranch for permission as we are gone frequently in the fall moving cattle. (406)287-3849
- BMA will be limited to first 500 hunters, after 500 hunters have been issued permission to hunt for the season, this BMA will be closed.
- Access Road in Section 5 off Hot Springs Road may be closed during inclement conditions at the landowners discretion. In this event a sign at the bottom of the road will indicate when it is closed. Please respect this closure as it is meant to prevent wear & tear on road and not to reduce hunter access.
- **State School Trust Land rules apply. Motorized vehicle use of roads on state land enrolled in BMA's shall be conducted in compliance with provisions and rules established in the BMA, except that off-road use is prohibited. This authorization is granted only for the dates in which the BMA is in effect. Upon termination or expiration of the BMA and for periods in which the BMA is not in effect, or at such times as DNRC may deem this authorization no longer appropriate, motorized vehicle use of roads on state land for general recreational purposes shall be conducted subject to the provisions of ARM36.25.149.**




Kountz Ranch Block Management Area #69 Map 1 of 2


