Arthun Ranches Block Management Area #6

Hunting Districts: D/E 315, 393 & 580; Ant 338; Moose 303

Township/Range: T6N-R9E, T6N-R8E, T5N-R8E, T5N-R7E, T5N-R9E, T4N-R8E, T4N-R9E, T3N-R9E, T2N-R8E & T2N-R9E

Huntable Game: White-Tailed Deer, Mule Deer, Elk, Antelope, Moose, Upland Birds & Waterfowl

Dates BMA is open: Legal Fall Hunting Seasons for White-Tailed Deer, Mule Deer, Elk, Antelope, Moose, Upland Birds & Waterfowl. *Elk hunting allowed 9/3/16-1/1/17. Refer to current hunting regulations for specific season information.

Maps to have before you go: This BMA Map, available free at Butte, Bozeman & Helena Area FWP offices, **AND** the Gallatin National Forest Map (East Half 2006 or North Map 2012), available for purchase through any Forest Service or Bozeman & Helena Area FWP offices.

Road Use: Vehicle travel permitted only on designated roads. Please refer to Gallatin National Forest Map (East Half 2006 or North Map 2012) for road use information on all roads outside of block management area boundaries.

How to get there: For Wilsall South and Ringling Units drive to Clyde Park MT on Hwy 89. Head north on Hwy 89 for approx. 6 miles to Shields River Lane (located 2 miles south of Wilsall). Turn left (west) onto Shields River Lane and proceed to the first ranch house on the left (south). For the Wilsall North Unit, drive to Wilsall, MT on U.S. Hwy 89. Proceed north and turn right (east) on Shields River Road. Proceed approximately 3 miles north on Shields River Road to Ron Arthun's ranch house at 285 Shields River Road. The Anderson place is located north on Anderson lane from the Shields River Road. Self-serve permission box is located approx. 2 miles up the road with designated parking approx. 2 miles beyond sign-in box. Sixteen Mile Unit is located North on Hwy 89 towards Ringling. Turn East on unmarked gravel road just North of mile marker 41. Travel 5.5 miles on this road until you enter Arthun property at sign-in box.

Ranch Rules:


- Access by written permission only at roster boxes. See map for sign-in box locations.
- Special Use Area: Youth 12-16, disabled and elderly hunters. Please be aware of your surroundings when taking your shot.
- Weapon Restricted Area: Limited to Archery, Shotgun, Muzzleloader and Traditional Handgun. Please be aware of your surroundings when taking your shot.
- Hunting is not allowed off Highway 89 between mile marker 18 and the town of Wilsall. Hunters must use designated access points to park and access this BMA. This rule is intended to address safety concerns if elk are in close range of the highway and houses.
- Access is first come, first served with certain hunter/day restrictions depending on the unit. Please place permission slip on the dashboard of your vehicle while hunting. Roster box areas will be checked at random periods to assure hunter compliance.
- Walk in hunting only, no off-road driving or 4-wheelers allowed. Special exceptions may be made for handicapped or senior citizens on an individual basis. Please park along established roads or at designated parking areas as posted. Please ask landowner about specific game retrieval possibilities. No horse hunting.
- No smoking or open fires.
- No Littering, including leaving flagging (surveyor tape) on bushes or tree branches. Please do not leave any game parts.
- Respect no shooting areas around buildings or where posted. Use caution near livestock.
- Anderson Place-Please check in at house prior to game retrieval.
- State School Trust Land rules apply. Motorized vehicle use of roads on state land enrolled in BMA's shall be conducted in compliance with provisions and rules established in the BMA, except that off-road use is prohibited. This authorization is granted only for the dates in which the BMA is in effect. Upon termination or expiration of the BMA and for periods in which the BMA is not in effect, or at such times as DNRC may deem this authorization no longer appropriate, motorized vehicle use of roads on state land for general recreational purposes shall be conducted subject to the provisions of ARM 36.25.149.

Every hunter must have permission. This includes possession of a written permission slip or signing in at a roster box **before** hunting.


