Dates BMA is open: Legal Fall Hunting Seasons for Mule Deer, White-Tailed Deer, Elk & Antelope. Refer to current hunting regulations for specific season information.

Maps to have before you go: This BMA Map, available free at Butte, Bozeman & Helena Area FWP offices, **AND** the Helena National Forest Travel Plan, available for purchase through any Forest Service or Bozeman & Helena Area FWP offices.

Road Use: Vehicle travel permitted only on designated roads. Please refer to the Helena National Forest Travel Plan for road use information on all roads outside of block management area boundaries.

How to get there: From Hwy 12, look for Filson Road between at mile marker 61. Turn East on Filson Rd. Go 1 mile to sign-in box.


Ranch Rules:

- Walk-in hunting with self administered roster limited to 12 people per day.
- No reservations will be taken. Roster limited to 12 hunters per day
- Every hunter must register at sign-in box each day before they hunt. Signature is part of permission requirement.
- No off road motor vehicle travel.
- Successful hunters may contact landowner for game retrieval.
- Please observe safety/no shooting zone.
- Wednesdays will allow disable hunters vehicular access to walk-in areas. Please be aware of this when planning your hunt.
