**Township/Range:** T2N-R9W, T2N-R8W & T1N-R9W

**Huntible Game:** White-Tailed Deer, Mule Deer, Elk, Antelope & Upland Birds

**Dates BMA is open:** Legal fall hunting seasons for Deer, Elk, Antelope & Upland Birds. Refer to current hunting regulations for specific season information.

**Maps to have before you go:** This BMA Map, available free at Butte, Bozeman & Helena Area FWP offices, **AND** the Beaverhead/Deerlodge National Forest Travel Plan 2008 (Central), available for purchase through any Forest Service or Bozeman & Helena Area FWP offices.

**Road Use:** Vehicle travel permitted only on designated roads. Please refer to the Beaverhead/Deerlodge National Forest Travel Plan 2008 (Central) for road use information on all roads outside of block management area boundaries.

**How to get there:** Fleeceer Unit - Take I-15 South from Butte to Feely Exit. Take Frontage Road south 2.5 miles to ranch headquarters. Rocker John Unit - I-15 Access-Take I-15 South from Butte to Feely Exit. Take Frontage Road north for 3 miles to access gate. Vehicles permitted beyond this gate only with permission. Beef Trail Access-Access from S. Montana St. 1.5 miles south of I-90. Turn west on Beef Trail Rd for 4 miles. Turn Left before subdivision. Park behind red ranch gate

## **Ranch Rules:**

### • **Rocker John Unit Rules:**

- **Permission-** Hunters must have a permission slip to hunt this property. Permission slip must be obtained in person at Smith 6-S Ranch (Meg's) located 2 miles south of Feely during the following days and times:
  - For Archery or Antelope Season: issued on 9/14/16 from 4-6pm.
  - For General Season: issued on 10/10-10/12/16 from 3-6pm.
- Photo ID is required to obtain a permission slip.
- Hunters must keep permission slip with them at all times while hunting and hang placard from rear view mirror.
- **Hunters must return comment card as condition of permission. Failure to return card may limit future access to this BMA.**
- **Access-**Walk-in only from the property gates during Archery and Antelope Season.
  - Access during the General Season is from designated parking areas. No motorized access beyond these areas except with Meg Smith's permission for retrieval.
  - No off-road motor vehicle use.
  - Leave gates as you found them and don't cut fences.
  - **Archery allowed on Beef Trail side of Rocker John unit only (shown on map) starting 9/15/16.** Access to the rest of Rocker John unit will not start until Antelope Season on 10/8/16 for antelope hunters only or General Season on 10/22/16 for deer and elk hunters.
  - No camping, littering or open fires allowed.
  - **No access for pre-season scouting.**

### • **Fleeceer Unit Rules:**


- **Permission-****Hunters must sign-in at roster box daily prior to hunting.** Hunter signature is permission to hunt this area.
- **Access-**Walk-in only from designated parking areas as signed. No motorized access beyond these areas except with Meg Smith's permission for retrieval.
  - No off-road motor vehicle use.
  - No camping, littering or open fires allowed.
  - **Remember that this is private land and is not part of the Fleeceer Wildlife Management Area.**

## **REMINDER: Access to Smith 6-S Livestock BMA is only for the hunting season.**

**Maps to have before you go:** This BMA Map, available free at Butte, Bozeman & Helena Area FWP offices, **AND** the Beaverhead/Deerlodge National Forest Travel Plan 2008 (Central), available for purchase through any Forest Service or Bozeman & Helena Area FWP offices.

**Road Use:** Vehicle travel permitted only on designated roads. Please refer to the Beaverhead/Deerlodge National Forest Travel Plan 2008 (Central) for road use information on all roads outside of block management area boundaries.

**How to get there:** From I-15, take the Glen exit, #85. Take the Schoolhouse road south for 2.1 miles. Take the first access to the right under the interstate, it is a culvert. Continue up Lost Creek approx 2 miles to Smith property, signs will indicate where to sign in. Walk in hunting permitted from box.


## **Ranch Rules:**

- Hunters must sign-in at roster box prior to hunting. Hunter signature is permission to hunt this area.
- Motorized vehicles restricted to designated routes and parking areas as signed. No off road motor vehicle use permitted.
- Landowners in this BMA ask that all hunters report wolf sightings to Fish, Wildlife & Parks through our website [fwp.mt.gov](http://fwp.mt.gov) under Montana wolves and wolf observations
- No Camping, littering or open fires allowed.
- **State School Trust Land rules apply. Motorized vehicle use of roads on state land enrolled in BMA's shall be conducted in compliance with provisions and rules established in the BMA, except that off-road use is prohibited. This authorization is granted only for the dates in which the BMA is in effect. Upon termination or expiration of the BMA and for periods in which the BMA is not in effect, or at such times as DNRC may deem this authorization no longer appropriate, motorized vehicle use of roads on state land for general recreational purposes shall be conducted subject to the provisions of ARM 36.25.149.**
