DEER/ELK HD 401 & ANTELOPE HD 401 (REVISED 2016)

DATES BMA IS OPEN: 1 Sept – through 1 Jan****See applicable hunting regulations for specific dates for each Species & Season****

ATTENTION: *Bears may be present on the Ranch, to include grizzlies. Exercise appropriate caution & the carry of Bear Spray is encouraged.*

HUNTABLE GAME: Open to All Legally Available Game Species

***Antelope & Water Fowl are Scarce - Elk may appear on rare occasions.**

WHERE & HOW TO GAIN ACCESS:

- All hunters must sign in at one of the sign in boxes once per day, prior to hunting.
- All hunters must fill out all information on any hunter record required for access.

HUNTERS: POLICE YOURSELVES AND REPORT ANY APPARENT MISCONDUCT OR VIOLATIONS

Be aware that private Landowners & staff have the authority to drive anywhere within the BMA but will always attempt to stay away from the area being hunted, unless need/situation demands otherwise.

BMA RULES & RESTRICTIONS:

- **OBEY ALL SAFETY ZONES AND LANDOWNERS INSTRUCTIONS.**
- Park in designated areas only or along the County Road. ♦ Do not block gates.
- Walk-in hunting from these areas.
- No Camping ♦ No Littering.
- No open flames or ignition sources allowed outside of vehicles.
- Smoking restricted to your inside your vehicle only.
- All vehicles restricted to public roads and authorized/designated trails.
- **No ATVs/OHVs allowed on BMA.**


STANDARD BLOCK MANAGEMENT PROGRAM RULES:

- BMA restrictions do not apply to legally accessible, (via public roads and watercourses, and other legal means of access) public (State or Federal) lands.
- A cooperator may deny access to an individual “for cause” IAW, ARM rule 12.4.205 (d). An example - intoxication, belligerence or violent behavior, violation of BMA rules, etc. Cooperators may also ask FWP to ban an individual(s) for cause. This will be via a formal letter to the individual(s) from FWP and will specify the length of the ban, reasons, and complainant.
- Violations of any BMA rules and/or State hunting regulations will be prosecuted. Convictions may result in the loss of Block Management access privileges in addition to other penalties.
