DEER/ELK HD 411 & ANTELOPE HD 420 (REVISED 2016)

Is open to public elk hunting only during the time period 1 Sep – 1 Jan, within the constraints of season dates and conditions outlined on page 116 of the 2016 Hunting Regulations.

DATES BMA IS OPEN: Archery & Rifle Seasons after 1 Sep / Upland Bird Seasons - through 1 Jan
****See applicable hunting regulations for specific dates for each Species & Season****

HUNTABLE GAME: Open to All Legally Available Game Species

WHERE & HOW TO GAIN ACCESS:

- **ANY ROAD NOT IDENTIFIED AS OPEN ON THIS MAP OR POSTED AS OPEN ON THE GROUND, IS BY DEFAULT CLOSED TO ALL MOTORIZED USE.**
- **ACCESS TO THIS AREA IS VIA AN EASEMENT ROAD FROM NORTH FORK RD & REQUIRES YOUR CROSSING OF PRIVATE LANDS NOT INCLUDED IN THE BMA.**
- **NO PARKING, TRESPASSING OR HUNTING FROM OR OFF OF THIS ROAD IS ALLOWED UNTIL YOU REACH THE DESIGNATED PARKING AREA ON STATE LANDS.**

BMA RULES & RESTRICTIONS:

- No written permission or reservations required.
- **MOTORIZED TRAVEL RESTRICTED TO DESIGNATED ROADS IDENTIFIED ON THIS MAP AS OPEN TO THE PUBLIC.**
- No motorized travel allowed across State lands outside of the easement road identified on this map.
- Parking restricted to designated area.
- Walk in hunting only from these areas.
- No rifle hunting amongst, or shooting around cattle.
- Hunters may not discharge a firearm within a quarter mile of live stock or an occupied building.
- **NO ATVs / OHVs ALLOWED ON BMA.**


STANDARD BLOCK MANAGEMENT PROGRAM RULES:

- BMA restrictions do not apply to legally accessible, (via public roads and watercourses, and other legal means of access) public (State or Federal) lands.
- A cooperator or their designated representative may deny access to an individual “for cause” IAW, ARM rule 12.4.205 (d). An example - intoxication, belligerence or violent behavior, violation of BMA rules, muddy/excessively filthy vehicle, etc. Cooperators may also ask FWP to ban an individual(s) for cause. This will be via a formal letter to the individual(s) from FWP and will specify the length of the ban, reasons, and complainant.
