

# **VIMY RIDGE BMA #112**

**DEER/ELK HD 400 & ANTELOPE HD 404 (REVISED 2016)**

**DATES BMA IS OPEN:** 1 Sep - through 1 Jan **\*\*See applicable hunting regulations for specific dates for each Species & Season\*\***

**HUNTABLE GAME:** Open to All Legally Available Game Species. **\*Antelope are Scarce or Rare**

**ATTENTION:** *In an effort to protect grizzly bears and promote public safety, hunters are advised that this BMA includes grizzly bear habitat. You are encouraged to carry / use bear spray in case of an encounter. Additional information on proper behavior when hunting in bear country is available from FWP*

## **WHERE & HOW TO GAIN ACCESS:**

- **Three areas with three separate access requirements.**
- **Permission or signing in at one location does not grant access to the other two areas.**
- All hunters must fill out all information on any hunter record required for access.

## **AREA "A"**

- No reservations.
- All hunters must sign in before hunting.
- **No hunting within 100 yards of any of the 3 houses or within 50 yards of shelterbelt around west compound.**

## **AREA "B"**

- **BEFORE & AFTER FIRST WEEK OF GENERAL RIFLE SEASON:**
- No reservations required. All hunters must sign in at box onsite.
- **ALL HUNTERS HUNTING FIRST WEEK OF GENERAL RIFLE SEASON.**
- Reservation required for this first week of the general rifle season only. Call **791-8234 BETWEEN 9am – 9pm** at least one day prior to hunting but no more than 21 days in advance of period you wish to hunt. Reservation line opened Oct 1 – Oct 27.
- Limit of 1 party of 1 –3 hunters per party, per day.
- Sign in at Sign-In box on site.

## **AREA "C"**

- No reservations required.
- All hunters must sign in prior to hunting.
- Place stub portion of coupon on dash face up while hunting.

## **BMA RULES & RESTRICTIONS:**

- **OBEY ALL SAFETY ZONES AND LANDOWNERS INSTRUCTIONS.**
- No motorized vehicles allowed off of public roads or designated private travel routes.
- Parking restricted to designated areas or along public travel routes & roads.
- No ATVs/OHVs allowed on private property within this BMA.


## **STANDARD BLOCK MANAGEMENT PROGRAM RULES:**

- BMA restrictions do not apply to legally accessible, (via public roads and watercourses, and other legal means of access) public (State or Federal) lands.
- In accordance with BMP ARM rule 12.4.205 (k) - On BMA's that restrict hunter numbers or require reservations, a hunter may not reserve permission on more than one BMA for the same day(s). For aggregate (multi cooperators) BMA's, a hunter, or a party may make reservations with up to three (3) cooperators within that BMA.
- Individual or party hunters may not reserve permission to hunt for more than three days, per phone call, per BMA and may not call more than once per day. Individuals from the same hunting party may not each make reservations for consecutive "three-day blocks" in an attempt to book more than three days for that party.
- Hunter(s) who fail to call at least 24 hours in advance to cancel a reservation may be banned from that BMA, or, for aggregate BMA's, from the property owned by the cooperator with whom they made the reservations.
- A cooperator or their designated representative may deny access to an individual "for cause" IAW, ARM rule 12.4.205 (d). An example - intoxication, belligerence or violent behavior, violation of BMA rules, muddy/excessively filthy vehicle, etc. Cooperators may also ask FWP to ban an individual(s) for cause. This will be via a formal letter to the individual(s) from FWP and will specify the length of the ban, reasons, and complainant.
- Violations of any BMA rules and/or State hunting regulations will be prosecuted. Convictions may result in the loss of Block Management access privileges in addition to other penalties.
