**DEER/ELK HD 449/454/540/580 & ANTELOPE HD 491/500/590 (REVISED 2016)**

**\*\*\*\*\*NO HUNTING OF ANY PIE BALD MOOSE ALLOWED\*\*\*\*\***

Is not participating in elk shoulder season hunting. Elk hunting **only** allowed during the standard 6-week archery season (Sep 3 – Oct 16) and the 5-week general rifle season (Oct 22 – Nov 27).

**DATES BMA IS OPEN:** Archery & Rifle Seasons after 1 Sept / Upland Bird Seasons - through 1 Jan  
**\*\*See applicable hunting regulations for specific dates for each Species & Season\*\***

**HUNTABLE GAME:** Open to All Legally Available Game Species

**WHERE & HOW TO GAIN ACCESS:** Written Permission required & issued in person, on-site at Ranch HQ's. 1/4 mile north of Highway 12 on USFS Access Rd Daisy Dean (a.k.a. Findon Lane).

- Permission slips issued **Mon, Thurs-Sat from 9 am – 5 pm**. They will not be issued on Sun, Tues & Wed. Hunting will still be allowed on these days, but hunters must pick up their slips prior to these days.

## **EXCEPTION**

- No permission slips will be issued Thanksgiving day. Hunting is still allowed, but hunters wishing to hunt on Thanksgiving day must pick up their permission slips before Thanksgiving.

## **BMA RULES & RESTRICTIONS:**

- **OBEY SAFETY ZONES AND RANCH STAFF INSTRUCTIONS:**
- Walk-in hunting only.
- Horses are allowed if you feed certified weed-seed free hay for 48 hours prior & during your hunt on the ranch.
- All motorized vehicles restricted to county roads or established, authorized secondary roads. No ATVs / OHVs allowed off these roads on this BMA.
- **NO MOTORIZED GAME RETRIEVAL ON PRIVATE RANCH ROADS ALLOWED**

## **HUNTING DISTRICT 449 (eastern), 540 & 580:**


- Martinsdale area - **shotgun** and **archery** only areas around structures & livestock in this area & along the North & South forks of the Musselshell River. Area is signed accordingly.

## **STANDARD BLOCK MANAGEMENT PROGRAM RULES:**

- BMA restrictions do not apply to legally accessible, (via public roads and watercourses, and other legal means of access) public (State or Federal) lands.
- In accordance with BMP ARM rule 12.4.205 (k) - On BMA's that restrict hunter numbers or require reservations, a hunter may not reserve permission on more than one BMA for the same day(s). For aggregate (multi cooperators) BMA's, a hunter, or a party may still only make reservations with one (1) cooperator within that BMA per day.
- Individual or party hunters may not reserve permission to hunt for more than three days, per phone call, per BMA and may not call more than once per day. Individuals from the same hunting party may not each make reservations for consecutive "three-day blocks" in an attempt to book more than three days for that party.
- Hunter(s) who fail to call at least 24 hours in advance to cancel a reservation may be banned from that BMA, or, for aggregate BMA's, from the property owned by the cooperator with whom they made the reservations.
- A cooperator or their designated representative may deny access to an individual "for cause" IAW, ARM rule 12.4.205 (d). An example - intoxication, belligerence or violent behavior, violation of BMA rules, muddy/excessively filthy vehicle, etc. Cooperators may also ask FWP to ban an individual(s) for cause. This will be via a formal letter to the individual(s) from FWP and will specify the length of the ban, reasons, and complainant.
- Violations of any BMA rules and/or State hunting regulations will be prosecuted. Convictions may result in the loss of Block Management access privileges in addition to other penalties.


