**DEER/ELK HD 404/421 & ANTELOPE HD 440 (REVISED 2016)**

**DATES BMA IS OPEN:** Archery & Rifle Seasons after 1 Sept / Upland Bird Seasons - through 1 Jan  
**\*\*See applicable hunting regulations for specific dates for each Species & Season\*\***

**HUNTABLE GAME:** Open to All Legally Available Game Species  
**\*Elk - Possibly, but should not be expected**

## **WHERE & HOW TO GAIN ACCESS:**

- Every hunter must sign in daily at one of the four sign-in boxes located at primary access points throughout BMA.
- All hunters must fill out all information on any hunter record required for access.

**THE ONLY AUTHORIZED ACCESS ROADS TO GAIN ENTRANCE ONTO THIS BMA ARE IDENTIFIED ON THIS MAP.** No other roads or trails may be used to gain access to or depart the BMA. Once hunters have legally accessed BMA and signed in, various travel routes within the BMA are available for motorized use, unless posted otherwise.

## **BMA RULES & RESTRICTIONS:**

- **OBEY SAFETY ZONES AND LANDOWNERS INSTRUCTIONS.**
- Park Along County Roads, Designated Spots Or Along Designated Trails, Do Not Block Gates.
- No Camping ♦ No Littering ♦ No Latrine Pits
- Horses Are **Not** Allowed On BMA
- No Open Flames Or Ignition Sources Allowed Outside Of Vehicles.
- Colony Members are not allowed to accompany hunters & hunters are not allowed to ride in Colony Vehicles.
- **NO ATVs/OHVs ALLOWED ON BMA.**
- All Motorized Vehicles Are Restricted To Public Roads and Authorized Trails.
- No Motorized Vehicles Allowed Off of These Roads/Trails.
- Walk In Hunting Only.


**HUNTERS: POLICE YOURSELVES & REPORT ANY APPARENT MISCONDUCT OR VIOLATIONS.**

## **STANDARD BLOCK MANAGEMENT PROGRAM RULES:**

- BMA restrictions do not apply to legally accessible, (via public roads and watercourses, and other legal means of access) public (State or Federal) lands.
- A cooperator or their designated representative may deny access to an individual “for cause” IAW, ARM rule 12.4.205 (d). An example - intoxication, belligerence or violent behavior, violation of BMA rules, muddy/excessively filthy vehicle, etc. Cooperators may also ask FWP to ban an individual(s) for cause. This will be via a formal letter to the individual(s) from FWP and will specify the length of the ban, reasons, and complainant.
- Violations of any BMA rules and/or State hunting regulations will be prosecuted. Convictions may result in the loss of Block Management access privileges in addition to other penalties.
