

# **BIRDTAIL BUTTE #147**

**DEER/ELK HD 421 & ANTELOPE HD 440 (REVISED 2014)**

**DATES BMA IS OPEN:** 1 Sep - through 1 Jan **\*\*See applicable hunting regulations for specific dates for each Species & Season\*\***

**Is not participating in elk shoulder season hunting.** Elk hunting **only** allowed during the standard 6-week archery season (Sep 3 – Oct 16) and the 5-week general rifle season (Oct 22 – Nov 27).

**ATTENTION:** *Bears may be present on the Ranch, to include grizzlies. Exercise appropriate caution & the carry of Bear Spray is encouraged.*

**HUNTABLE GAME:** Open to All Legally Available Game Species

**WHERE & HOW TO GAIN ACCESS:**

- All hunters in party must sign in at box each day before beginning your hunt.

**BMA RULES & RESTRICTIONS:**

- **ALL OTHER ROADS/TRAILS NOT IDENTIFIED ON THE MAP AS OPEN ARE BY DEFAULT CLOSED TO MOTORIZED USE.**
- All vehicles restricted to the designated access road.
- Parking restricted to within 30 feet anywhere along access road or in designated parking areas.
- NO ROAD HUNTING ALLOWED
- Walk-in hunting only from road/trail.
- No Horses allowed
- No Camping ♦ No Littering ♦ No Latrine Pits Left Visible
- No open flames or ignition sources allowed outside of vehicles.
- **No ATVs / OHVs allowed on BMA.**

**HUNTERS: POLICE YOURSELVES & REPORT ANY APPARENT MISCONDUCT OR VIOLATIONS.**


**STANDARD BLOCK MANAGEMENT PROGRAM RULES:**

- BMA rules restricting the hunting/harvesting of game by species or sex do not apply to public lands within the boundary of the BMA. Commission approved restrictions as identified in current hunting regulation apply to all lands within any BMA.
- A cooperator or their designated representative may deny access to an individual “for cause” IAW, ARM rule 12.4.205 (d). An example - intoxication, belligerence or violent behavior, violation of BMA rules, muddy/excessively filthy vehicle, etc. Cooperators may also ask FWP to ban an individual(s) for cause. This will be via a formal letter to the individual(s) from FWP and will specify the length of the ban, reasons, and complainant.
- Violations of any BMA rules and/or State hunting regulations will be prosecuted. Convictions may result in the loss of Block Management access privileges in addition to other penalties.


