DEER/ELK HD 446/416/452/449 & ANTELOPE HD 490/491 (REVISED 2016)

BMA is open to public elk hunting only during the time period of 1 Sep – 1 Jan, within the constraints of season dates and conditions outlined on page 116 of the 2016 Hunting Regulations.

DATES BMA IS OPEN: Archery & Rifle Seasons after 1 Sep / Upland Bird Seasons - through 1 Jan
****See applicable hunting regulations for specific dates for each Species & Season****

HUNTERS MUST HAVE MAP ON THEIR PERSON WHILE HUNTING.

HUNTABLE GAME: Open to All Legally Available Game Species

WHERE & HOW TO GAIN ACCESS:

- All hunters must sign in daily at ONE BMA Box before hunting.
- All hunters must fill in all information on coupon.
- Place coupon stub on dash face up.

BMA RULES & RESTRICTIONS: OBEY SAFETY ZONES AND LANDOWNERS INSTRUCTIONS.

- Park along county road or in designated location only. Do not block gates.
- Walk-in hunting only from these areas.
- Horses may be used to hunt from and/or retrieve with.
- No camping, no littering, no latrine pits on private land.
- **No hunting among the livestock.**
- No open flames or ignition sources allowed outside of vehicles.
- In district 416 or west side map, hunters may not access the adjacent DNRC (blue) school trust lands as identified with an asterisk, from this BMA.
- No motorized travel allowed on BMA.
- No ATV's / OHV's allowed on BMA.

HUNTERS: POLICE YOURSELVES & REPORT ANY APPARENT MISCONDUCT OR VIOLATIONS.

Be aware that private Landowners & staff have the authority to drive anywhere within the BMA but will always attempt to stay away from areas being hunted, unless need/situation demands otherwise.


STANDARD BLOCK MANAGEMENT PROGRAM RULES:

- BMA restrictions do not apply to legally accessible, (via public roads and watercourses, and other legal means of access) public (State or Federal) lands.
- A cooperator or their designated representative may deny access to an individual “for cause” IAW, ARM rule 12.4.205 (d). An example - intoxication, belligerence or violent behavior, violation of BMA rules, muddy/excessively filthy vehicle, etc. Cooperators may also ask FWP to ban an individual(s) for cause. This will be via a formal letter to the individual(s) from FWP and will specify the length of the ban, reasons, and complainant.
- Violations of any BMA rules and/or State hunting regulations will be prosecuted. Convictions may result in the loss of Block Management access privileges in addition to other penalties.
